WFWP – Carinthia Report

From there together with some leaders & other members and participants we drove 10 minutes by car to the venue at the old castle of Manison Lisicje in Skofljica, Slovenia. The program started with an opening song "Slovenian Girl" by the folk singers TASCICE followed by a warm WELCOME greetings from our dynamic programme moderator Ms. Kristina BACOVNIK.
