WFWP was founded in 1992 by the late Dr. Sun Myung Moon and his wife, Dr. Hak Ja Han Moon, in Seoul, South Korea, to empower women with the dignity and qualities that are theirs, in all facets of life, both in the private and public sphere.

We first had a presentation of the Association by Marcia de Abreu, our National President and Secretary General of WFWP Europe and Middle East. A video was projected on the activities carried out at an international level and some slides of those that we have carried out in Spain, such as Bridges of Peace, seminars, workshops, promotion of young women, etc.

Next, Mrs. Ana García Arroyo, a doctor in English Philology and writer, very knowledgeable about India, spoke to us about the esoteric book Linga Purana, and her Vedic predictions about the Kali Yuga, which describes with great precision what we see in our society today. It was exciting. Next, the musical group Las Freedras (from Mexico) and the singer Mariana performed, which gave us a beautiful musical interlude.

In the second part of the program, we had the contribution of Isabel Mercadé, a professor of religious culture who promoted the creation of the Inter-religious Choir for Peace, of the Unesco Association for Inter-religious Dialogue (AUDIR).

They sing songs from different traditions, creating a transformative experience for the singers and all who listen. Thus, everyone is enriched and feels close at heart through the harmony created. Vicky Uribe enlivened this presentation, soloist of the choir, singing a miscellany of some of her songs, contributing to her color and spirituality.

We ended the event by blowing out the 30th-anniversary candles and sharing snacks with the hope of undertaking, in this new phase, many projects for cooperation, friendship, and peace with women from all over the world.
