

21 Couples Attend Moldovan Marriage Rededication

A Happy Family Festival was held on August 11 in the village of Ruseștii Noi in Moldova's Ialoveni District.

About 60 guests attended the event, which was organized by FFWPU of Moldova as part of its strategy to spread its activities from the capital to the villages.
