Claudine talked about some of the WFWP activities in Congo DRC as well as in South Africa that she had been involved in prior to coming to Sweden. Dorcas Dadzie from Ghana talked about her organization that she started at her workplace called "Give to life". Abubakar Mohamud, a young man from Göteborg talked about his work with the Elman Peacecenter in Somalia. There were a few other organizations as well present. A young lady shared her poem about women as peacemakers behind the scene. Asha moved everyone when she started singing a traditional Somali song that everyone joined in on.
