26th May

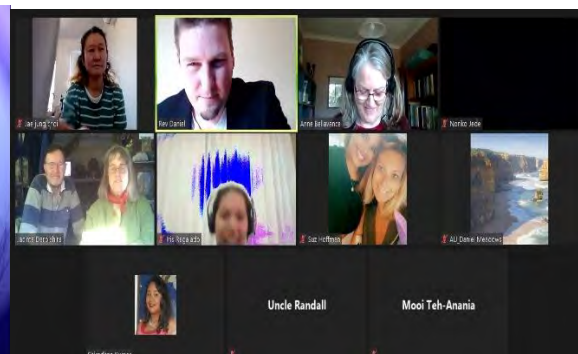
