



In Memoriam Eva Slováková

Nitra, Slovakia, November 18, 2018

On November 18, 2018, we said farewell with our dear sister, Eva Slováková, who left for the spiritual world at the age of nearly 74. The funeral took place at the city cemetery in Nitra with the participation of her relatives and acquaintances, as well as our brothers and sisters. Coincidentally, the Seonghwa ceremony took place together with the Roman Catholic ceremony in the chapel at the cemetery. First the Roman Catholic priest made a religious ceremony, and then we performed a Seonghwa ceremony with a song, speeches, prayers and video presentation with photographs from Eva's life. All this was done with the participation of a priest who could thus get to know a lot of unexpected information.

After the ceremony in the chapel, we proceeded to the grave. We performed the Wonjeon

ceremony, and then the Roman Catholic priest performed the respective religious ceremony. After the coffin had been put to the grave,

the people bid farewell to Eva by throwing flowers to her grave. Many people, especially our brothers and sisters coming from near and far, came to say goodbye to Eva. From the time she got to know the Divine Principle and True Parents, Eva has continually tried to make use of her healing abilities in line with the Divine Principle, and to help people come to God and create marriages and families centered on God. By doing so, she has entered lives and hearts of many people. After the ceremony at the cemetery, we prepared in Nitra church center, where Eva, being a church leader of Nitra for 8 years, had spent so much time, the opportunity for all the brothers and sisters to meet thinking of Eva. The sisters prepared a rich refreshment, and we spent time sharing until the evening.

Eva met the Divine Principle in the summer of 1994, and then, after receiving the lectures and getting to know about True Parents, joined the Unification Movement. Before the Principle, Eva practiced Reiki and was interested in the monad (yang and yin). After learning the Principle, she began

developing her healing skills and developed new healing methods she summarized in the Biltera project. Thus, she could help many people to eliminate physical and spiritual problems. Within Biltera, she organized trainings both in Slovakia and abroad, and could naturally introduce the background of her method, whether the Divine Principle or other information from the Unification Movement. In this way she brought many people to the Movement and to the Blessing.

Since Eva was born in Nitra, lived and worked there, it was natural that in November 2005, after the previous city leader had left for another mission, she was appointed a city leader. She served as such until 2013. During this period, she continued with the Biltera project and together with members in Nitra supported the activities of True Parents, either by participating in a tour of True Parents or members of True Family in Slovakia or abroad or by various lectures. During that time, in 2011, a large reconstruction of the Nitra center began, in which Eva will be missed very much.
