The children fed are mainly abandoned or orphaned children, who normally don't have guaranteed rations of food in their homes. We hope to be able to distribute even more meals to more children.



WFWP Côte d'Ivoire focuses on raising their community up and they plan to hold a "Training Workshop" for the transformation of raw materials with women on September 18. In this workshop, women will learn how to transform Hibiscus flowers and ginger into a syrup that may be used to cook with or simply drink.
