

Revisiting what happened when Hyun Jin Moon visited his father at the hospital

I'm going to briefly explain what happened when Hyun Jin Nim tried to go see True Father's body. This post has three parts: 1) First Hospital visit 2) Second Hospital visit, 3) Cheon Jeung Gung visits after True Father passed away (in a separate post). For a more detailed account go to trueaccount.tumblr.com. I'll try to stick to the facts as much as possible without adding personal commentary.

1) Hospital visit number 1:

Hyun Jin Nim was not informed by anyone about True Father's health condition. While True Father was in the St. Mary's hospital in Seoul, Hyun Jin Nim was staying at a hotel right across the street from the hospital where True Father was. When True Father's public appearances stopped and there was no more Hoon Dok Haes being shown, Hyun Jin Nim and the people around him got suspicious. At that point they did their own independent "research" and heard the rumor that True Father was at the St. Mary's hospital across the street from where Hyun Jin Nim was.

They sent a person to check the situation on the morning of August 15. The person went through the entire hospital and searched all the ICU rooms. He did not see one church member and did not see any security guards anywhere in the hospital. Finally, he went to the 21st floor where the VIP waiting room is. There he met face to face with Peter Kim. He asked Peter Kim if True Father was here or not. Peter Kim answered yes. But, Peter Kim knew that this person works with Hyun Jin Nim. As soon as the person left the hospital (around 10:40 AM), the church began to put up news that True Father was ill and that they had contacted all the True Children about it.

Upon receiving confirmation that True Father was in the hospital, Hyun Jin Nim went immediately and first went to the 6th floor to see True Father's doctor to understand the gravity of the situation. The doctor gave him permission to visit True Father at the ICU. Hyun Jin Nim went to the ICU room, and now there were 4 security guards blocking the way. But since Hyun Jin Nim had the doctor's permission and the doctor overrules these guards, he could enter without incident. At this moment it is assumed that the guards alerted their superiors that Hyun Jin Nim stepped in to see True Father.

In the ICU, Hyun Jin Nim and Jun Sook Nim had a supervised visit but it was the first private moment they had with True Father in 3 years. It would also be their last. According to the reports I have, Hyun Jin Nim cried and begged True Father to get up and get well again. And True Father, who was under medication, supposedly squeezed Hyun Jin Nim's hand in a form of assurance/affirmation or consolation towards him.

After 4 minutes into the visit, Kook Jin Nim's couple, Hyung Jin Nim's couple, and a whole group of leaders came to the ICU room. Kook Jin Nim took a forceful approach and told Hyun Jin Nim that he had to go. Kook Jin Nim interrupted him saying that, "That's enough. That's it. You have to go." To which Hyun Jin Nim replied, "Did you come down here to make a scene?" To that, Kook Jin Nim replied, "I'm not afraid of you. You have no right. If you want to take it outside, I can take it outside."

At that point, Hyun Jin Nim decided to go rather than cause a scene in front of a sick True Father. He promised True Father he'd come back again and left. After Hyun Jin Nim left the hospital, the church did a press conference where Mr. Ho Yeol Ahn told the press that True Father was "unconscious". It was odd that they would announce this specific news to the world. And Dr. Seuk sent out a letter saying that True Father was in a "deep sleep". Tim Elder on his Tongil Foundation page said that it would be a "medical

impossibility" for True Father to have been conscious. The reason they were trying to establish that fact was to discredit and remove any value in Hyun Jin Nim's visit.

2) Hospital visit number 2:

After the first hospital visit, Hyun Jin Nim went on to do his GPF event that had the theme and purpose of the Unification of North and South Korea. The event and conference turned out to be huge successes. After finishing the event Hyun Jin Nim wanted to report this victory to True Father and offer it up. He was planning to go visit before August 25. However, this time the church had taken further measures to prevent Hyun Jin Nim from meeting with True Father.

This time the church hired more security guards, mobilized young CARP members to monitor the hospital lobby and other areas, called police to be on standby, and even implemented legal procedures to prevent Hyun Jin Nim's entry. The church publicly argued that these guards were all put in place to prevent the press from disturbing True Father. However, the press was not going to barge into an ICU room. And the church had also mobilized CARP members to monitor the lobby of the hotel where Hyun Jin Nim was staying (there are pictures as proof). Why put CARP kids to guard the hotel Hyun Jin Nim is staying at? The press will go there too? And finally, they also put legal procedures in place to prevent him from going in. So their clear intention seems to be that they took all those measures to prevent Hyun Jin Nim from going to see True Father. And they succeeded at that.

3) After True Father passed

After True Father passed away the church published an official list of bereaved family members on major newspapers in Korea. This list included all the names of the extensive True Family, including In Jin Nim and Jin Sung Nim who didn't go to the Seong Hwa. But it excluded Hyun Jin Nim and his entire family. This list was officially approved by Hyung Jin Nim who was named the chairperson for the Seonghwa Committee. They decided not to include the eldest son, grandson, and great grandson of True Father. Even the children that Hyun Jin Nim gave to Hoon Sook Nim were not included in the list as if to say that they are from a different lineage.

The official explanation that a church representative gave to the Korean press is that the Seonghwa Committee held a meeting about the issue of including or removing Hyun Jin Nim's entire family from the list of bereaved family members and they came to the conclusion that, "Organization is more important than lineage".

Anyway, after that happened Hyun Jin Nim had to decide whether to go to see True Father's body or not. It was obvious that the church leaders would try to block him or try to cause an incident. Probably knowing that it was futile he tried. A day or two before going, Hyun Jin Nim announced that he was going to go with a group of people.

Then Hyun Jin Nim went on September 10 to Chung Pyung to pay his respects. He went with a group of members and "VIPs". When they arrived they were met with church leaders, security guards, and police officials (3 buses worth of police). They were not letting them go in. The church leaders said that only Hyun Jin Nim was being allowed to enter alone. The members and church leaders tried to negotiate back and forth. The members said then that they will agree to not go to see True Father's body, but that they want to be allowed to walk half way up the road of the mountain to make sure that Hyun Jin Nim makes it inside without any incident. This was denied.

At that point, the members sang holy songs, made a full kyung-bae, prayed and left. Hyun Jin Nim also left. The "negotiations" and subsequent singing of songs, prayer, and bows in respect to True Father was interpreted as a "riot" by church authorities.

The main point that the church leaders were arguing is that Hyun Jin Nim's people were not following proper protocol. That means they are essentially saying that if they had submitted their names and followed proper protocol, they would have been allowed. They said that members came from all around the world and are waiting in line to see True Father's body and that the people who came with Hyun Jin Nim are no exception and would supposedly be allowed in only if they had followed "proper protocol". That is a very reasonable argument from the church side.

Except that it is being applied poorly. The reason these members came with Hyun Jin Nim was because they were worried the church would do something to hurt Hyun Jin Nim's image. For example, that someone would try to provoke Hyun Jin Nim into doing/saying something stupid and have it filmed. Because of the current lawsuits the stakes are really high on both sides and the tension is really high. Hyun Jin Nim's side argument would be that in this situation the sensible thing to do would be to allow them to go in, pay their respects, and come out. Make an exception. That would be a sign of good will.

The next day Hyun Jin Nim attempted his final visit to Chung Pyung to pay his respects. Once again he went with a group of members. This time there were Japanese members blocking the road. This time Hyun Jin Nim attempted to enter "alone" accompanied with some 30 or so 2nd gens. However, the church side said he would have to sign a certain document in order to enter. In other words, Hyun Jin Nim was not going to be allowed to enter be it with or without members, if he did not sign this document. Tim Elder denies the part about the document. But then again Tim Elder denies many things that are true. According to certain sources, on the second attempt by Hyun Jin Nim to see True Father's body, True Mother said "let him go in" and she actually gave the okay for him to go with his group. However, it was Kook Jin Nim who stepped in and vetoed True Mother's decision. Kook Jin Nim, who is in charge of Japan, mobilized the Japanese members to block the road, thereby defying True Mother, presenting a document as a condition for him to enter, and probably creating an eternal "han" [*han* can be roughly translated as *resentment*.] in Hyun Jin Nim's heart for not being able to properly pay his final respects to True Father.
