

Hyun Jin Nim's heart for True Mother

On my second day in the United States during Hoon Dok Hae we read Hyun Jin Nim's letter to True Mother. We read through the letter only once and after that it was collected, but it seems to me this letter were written in three stages. If my memory is correct, the first part was written based on Divine Principle; the second part was his frank straight talk to True Mother; the third part was a deep expression of his love for True Mother. I found the letter to be a very honest and straight forward without any unnecessary words, which I felt very much reflected his character.

When I finished reading it, one word that really popped out in my mind was the word "Truth". No lies and falsehood, just the truth and nothing but the truth is directly spoken and then for the first time I felt I understood very well the difficulties which True Family had gone through.

I do not remember whether it was 2010 or 2011, but at one meeting with Hyun Jin Nim, one member asked him why he was not "coming back to True Parents". I remember very well his answer. "It is to protect True Family." He didn't give any other excuses or explanations. He has been showing his heart through his actions, with his mouth shut, while repeatedly having been beaten up again and again.

The church portrayed Hyun Jin Nim as if he left True Parents by rebelling against them. And even now some people say that he is attacking True Mother. That is not true.

As I read through his letter to True Mother I was so touched by his deep love for her. Even though some parts are written with harsh expression, I still felt all of them were spoken truly out of his deep concern for True Mother.

That evening, after dinner, the meeting continued at the dinner table, in which Hyun Jin Nim spoke to us with his heavy-looking face saying "I wished I hadn't needed to show this letter to anyone. I was going to take it to the grave." He said he had been trying for a long time to solve all the problems by directly meeting with True Mother but it hadn't worked out. He, therefore, wanted to share his true will, for which he had kept silent, with the leaders even by sharing his private letter. At the end of the meeting he said,

"I believe in you guys"!

From reading the contents of the letter I just want to tell you that Hyun Jin Nim loves True Mother and is concerned about her. And he longs for the day when he can walk the course of Providence together with her

There was one more reason why I decided to work with Hyun Jin Nim besides having been touched by his love for True Mother. That was that I felt his desperate heart for the Providence to accomplish God's will which True Father wanted to accomplish.

Many members may think that the quickest way for all things to be resolved is for Hyun Jin Nim to come back to True Mother and carry out the Providence by becoming one with her. However, when we think about it realistically can the current Unification Church and its current leadership achieve the goals of North and South unification, solve the world hunger issues as well as develop super-national, super-religious movement to achieve peaceful world?

In Japan, currently the "Unification Church" has lost its public trust as it is sometimes identified with the notorious Aum Shinrikyo. In Korea, with its Christian majority population, you would lose cooperation from others in an instance if they find out the Unification Church is involved. If you ever experienced social activities in the church-related organization, you may know what I'm talking about.

Some people say that once the top changes, then everything will change. However, it is not easy at all to change the church's organizational culture, which has already been firmly formed, as well as to restore its social trust that has been lost. Hyun Jin Nim said he made every effort again and again to go back to be with True Parents but now the situation has become so difficult even if he spent the rest of his life for it may be too late.

I was thinking to convey to Hyun Jin Nim some opinion from the church side such as, "Now the church has changed from when it aggressively kept attacking you (Hyun Jin Nim). True Mother has appointed good leaders now and the atmosphere is more favorable for your return." (Especially when I found out how many working at the world HQ in Korea are those who know Hyun Jin Nim well and those who I have favorable impression as people of no selfish interests) However, when I saw Hyun Jin Nim who was totally convinced that we would be able to achieve Father's dream of the unification of North and South, and desperately determined to achieve it at the risk of his life, I could not say anything to him.

If you think seriously about achieving God's will, how can Hyun Jin Nim become the Unification Church leader now? I realized that I was really not convinced and serious about realizing substantial Cheon II Guk as Hyun Jin Nim is, and I felt so ashamed about myself.

My question is this: Should Hyun Jin Nim go back to Unification Church, or should Unification Church apologize about their lies about him and support him?

I wish everyone could have experienced Korea GPLC this time. You would be so moved to see our movement being recognized by society at this high unprecedented level and feel your hard work is finally paying off. Even though we have been through a period of misunderstanding and difficulties it is so good to see the incredible support coming now.

I want Unification Church leaders who do public work to seriously think about how to achieve the unification of North and South, and how to save the world. And I want them to tell to the members, that there is HOPE.

Also Hyun Jin Nim has not been able to forget about all the Unification Church members and families, even though he has been ridiculed and despised by many of them and while thinking of them he continues to build a great foundation.
