How to Minister your Children to the Gospel

God bless you, folks! Thank you, PA, and all the folks down there holding it down. The Rod of Iron Freedom Festival is coming soon; please be ready for that. Let's get to our Scripture! Acts 5: 1-11

1 But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession,

2 And kept back part of the price, his wife also being privy to it, and brought a certain part, and laid it at the apostles' feet.

3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?

4 Whiles it remained, was it not thine own? and after it was sold, was it not in thine own power? why hast thou conceived this thing in thine heart? thou hast not lied unto men, but unto God.

5 And Ananias hearing these words fell down, and gave up the ghost: and great fear came on all them that heard these things.

6 And the young men arose, wound him up, and carried him out, and buried him.

7 And it was about the space of three hours after, when his wife, not knowing what was done, came in.

8 And Peter answered unto her, Tell me whether ye sold the land for so much? And she said, Yea, for so much.

9 *Then Peter said unto her, How is it that ye have agreed together to tempt the Spirit of the Lord? behold, the feet of them which have buried thy husband are at the door, and shall carry thee out.*

10 Then fell she down straightway at his feet, and yielded up the ghost: and the young men came in, and found her dead, and, carrying her forth, buried her by her husband.

11 And great fear came upon all the church, and upon as many as heard these things.

So, we're in Acts chapter 5. Of course, this is written by Luke, and he's outlining the works of the early church. Remember, Christ is no longer incarnate; he's now appearing powerfully with the Holy Spirit. This is now the church age when the Holy Spirit is moving powerfully and all these miracles are happening. Of course, the church is growing and we see it in this chapter. Tremendous growth! Good people being witnessed, and people realizing who Jesus was, and then having total transformation through faith, and receiving spiritual salvation.

Now obviously if Christ had a lineage on earth and that lineage was his sons and his kingship that would spread the Gospel, then an actual kingdom would appear; an actual physical kingdom would appear. But since it was the disciples who were not his kingship or lineage, then we see a spiritual kingdom appear, which nonetheless does provide spiritual salvation and does connect people to Christ. Of course, that's why Christ said he will return. Amen!

This is a very interesting chapter and we should look at it very carefully because this is a rhema. I love rhemas because you don't get to choose. You don't get to choose what piece of Scripture you're going to be studying; God chooses. This is what I received this morning. Ananias' name means "God is faithful," isn't that interesting?

Now let's see what was just before then; let's start in verse 32.

Acts 4:32-35

32 And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common.

They're literally like in a commune; they're pioneering. See folks, the pioneering stage is where they have to go all in; that's why the first generation you all suffered greatly and had to walk the path of serving Father. The point is: it's the pioneering stage. You can't regret that; there has to be a price that has to be paid. God needs to have His Kingdom expanded, the Gospel preached, people being saved et cetera. There's a period of time even in the early church -look at this- where they literally live in communes. Why? Because everywhere else they go they're attacked. They're just young people; they're just like in their teens and twenties; maybe some of them in their thirties or forties. They don't have tons of resources so they have to band together to fight this great battle against Satan. It doesn't

stay that way forever and it shouldn't, but in the midst of a spiritual warfare with nothing and the whole world against you, well you have to band together; you really do have to band together, right?

33 And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.

34 *Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold,*

35 And laid them down at the apostles' feet: and distribution was made unto every man according as he had need.

36 *And Joses, who by the apostles was surnamed Barnabas, (which is, being interpreted, The son of consolation,) a Levite, and of the country of Cyprus,*

37 Having land, sold it, and brought the money, and laid it at the apostles' feet.

This is right before chapter 5. This man sold a big piece of land and he donated the whole thing to the early community of Christ, the very poor community of Christ; he donated the whole land that he had. Obviously, as he donated that whole land, he got a lot of accolades; they gave him the name Barnabas, *"the son of consolation!"* They're blessing him and saying, *"Wow! This man is a man of God; look how generous he is!"*

Then next chapter, chapter 5 what happens? You have Ananias and Sapphira they pop up and all of a sudden, they say, "*Hey! We've sold some land too!*" They of course want to get all that praise; they want to get that praise. They've been good and faithful people of the poor community of Christ that is now under tremendous persecution. They've persecuted, imprisoned, they've been killed, hung upside down, crucified et cetera - you name it. And now Ananias is coming and saying, "*I also sold a piece of my land and I want great praise for that.*"

Now, it's interesting; look at that closely.

Chapter 5

1 But a certain man named Ananias, with Sapphira his wife, sold a possession,

2 And kept back part of the price, his wife also being privy to it, and brought a certain part, and laid it at the apostles' feet.

So just before, you saw Barnabas getting all that praise. He sold the land; he's helping the poor community of Christ that's being persecuted, mocked, imprisoned, tortured, hung upside down and killed - you name it. Then Ananias and his wife come up and what does it say? "*Being privy to it*"; they knew. They said, "*We sold some land too! Here's the big donation we're going to make to the church. All the community of Christ believers, be grateful to us; we're making a BIG donation.*" But then what happened? They were privy to something. To what?

3 But Peter said, Ananias, why hath Satan filled thine heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?

You see what I'm saying? It wasn't the donation that God was upset at through Peter; it was what? Ananias was trying to get the praise, and Ananias was trying to DECEIVE! Let's say Barnabas gave 100,000 dollars, and let's say Ananias sold his property for 300,000. Then he comes to the church community and says, *"Look what I brought you: a 120,000-dollar donation!"* Now that's bigger than Barnabas'; it's \$20,000 bigger than Barnabas', right. When Joses gave the big donation, they were like,

- "Wow! Joses we're going to now give you the name Barnabas, 'the son of consolation'. We're going to bless you; you are amazing, incredible!"

- "Hey! Hey! But I got a 120,000-dollar donation for you!"

Do you see what I'm saying folks?

Deceiving for reputation

But what happened? He sold it for \$300,000 and he comes in saying, "I'm going to give \$120,000," to DECEIVE the people and to deceive God. In the end the Scripture actually said, "Why do you LIE to the Holy Spirit?" Even though Barnabas gave \$100,000 -or \$10,000 or whatever- it was the whole thing, and he was truly giving so that the community of believers could be stronger and they could fight the spiritual warfare. Amen!

Then Ananias comes up and he wants to do what? DECEIVE; he wants to pretend just because he sees the numbers, *"Oh, he gave 100; I give 120."* But he's KEEPING 180! So, he's pretending that he sold this HUGE land and that he's so incredibly generous for giving ALL the money to the community of Christ. You see what I'm saying? Nevertheless, he pocketed 180,000 - let's say for example. This is just all hypothetical; we don't know the numbers but just to give you a picture. Amen! So, he and his wife were privy to it; both of them!

Now what does this show? God doesn't care about the amount of the donation, of the giving, of the support to the community of Christ; that's not what God is after.

In Mark 12:43-44 we read,"43 Calling his disciples to him, Jesus said, "Truly I tell you, this poor widow has put more into the treasury than all the others. 44 They all gave out of their wealth; but she, out of her poverty, put in everything – all she had to live on."

Because God is looking for what? The heart, the HEART to be generous. To whom? To God and His community, to His children. In this case, this is His adopted children; they're like the orphans that God is raising up to do His warfare against Satan and the forces of evil. Amen!

So, God is interested in what? Is this person Ananias DECEIVING for what? Reputation? Is he LYING? He's doing some good obviously; \$120,000 can help the church- this is all hypothetical numbers- it can help that early church community; I'm sure. But he's trying to get the credit as if like Barnabas, he gave the whole thing, *"I'm so generous, just like Barnabas. Give me a blessing, give me an accolade; recognize me, recognize me!"* Are you with me folks? By trying to do that he's DECEIVING! Not only is he trying

to deceive the Holy Spirit, but he's trying to deceive his own brothers and sisters in Christ, "Worship me! Hey, I did better than Barnabas, I gave more than Barnabas! WORSHIP me!" That's bad! That's bad, because in the end who's that hurting? That's not only hurting the heart of God, that's not only hurting your brothers and sisters; in the end that's hurting you. Amen! In the end that DECEIVER is hurting himself; he's sabotaging himself. Are you with me folks?

That's why God wants that honesty and generosity because it's not easy to be generous, to help other people etc. It's not easy but it has to be done HONESTLY, not for praise.

Jesus himself says to give and not even mention that you gave:

"But when you give to the poor, do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing, so that your giving may be in secret." (Matt 6:3-4)

"When you pray go into the closet and pray for your Father in Heaven hears Thee." "But thou, when thou prayest, enter into thy closet, and when thou hast shut thy door, pray to thy Father which is in secret" (Matt 6:6)

What do the Pharisees do? They come on the highways and byways; they get up on the streets shouting and hollering, praying loud and looking out. They pray long prayers as if they were holy. Amen!

"And when you pray, you shall not be like the hypocrites. For they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the corners of the streets, that they may be seen by men" (Matt 6:5) "Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer:" (Matt 23:14)

So, God is talking about that: don't try to DECEIVE for reputation! That's not our God! Our God is not like, *"God, make me famous so I can have a great reputation!"* No! He said,

"If you follow me you got to pick up your cross" *"If anyone would come after me, let him deny himself and take up his cross and follow me" (Matt 16:24)*

"Be ready to be scorned, mocked, hated, KILLED for my namesake!"

"And you will be hated by all for My name's sake" (Matt 10:22)

"Then they will deliver you over to be persecuted and killed, and you will be hated by all nations because of My name." (Matt 24:9)

That's what he said.

He didn't say, "*Get ready to be famous and loved by the satanic world*." No! You're going to be HATED by the satanic world. Amen! But even though you are shunned by the world you are ACCEPTED by the Creator of the universe, and the Creator of the universe is bigger than the world and all those naysayers and all those crazies that try to shame you. A lion's not a sheep!

This is what God is upset about. And what happened? He gets struck down; Ananias gets killed. Boom! He gets vaporized. (*Laughing*) No, he doesn't; he just falls dead. And then his wife, she was privy to it too and she dies too.

God is saying, "We're setting up the community of Christ right now; this is the earliest stages. We're just launching the spiritual community of Christ because of the faithlessness of people; they killed Jesus and now Providence has to keep moving forward at least with spiritual salvation. We have to bring the Kingdom in the spirit at least, so we got to move forward." Literally it's like grand opening week and this is taking place. It just begins and then this kind of insanity happens. God is putting out a big warning, "We're not going to start with this kind of standard. We don't want people who are coming here to GIVE so they can get a big plaque. We want people who are here that are truly invested, that are in for the fight of their lives against the Devil; who are here for the real reason."

Now, think about this: even on a macrocosm level with the neocons, they're always proclaiming, "*Oh! Yeah! I'm for the Constitution! Yeah, I support guns and the Second Amendment!*" Then they go and they vote trying to help the lefties put it away. All they're doing is DECEIVING, for what? Reputation. As conservative people we HATE it when the politicians do that! They're DECEIVING us, saying that they support the Second Amendment or freedom of speech or whatever it is. They're saying that to get our vote, and when they get into Washington all they do is just rip it up in shred and of course pad their pockets! Amen! Don't we hate that, folks? It aggravates our nerves; it makes your blood boil because YOU KNOW we're not supposed to do that. There has to be an HONESTY in our reputation. Amen!

Usually, honest people are quite persecuted. There are also deceitful people that are , but if you're honest against Satan then usually you're persecuted. The point is: we don't like it when somebody is using DECEPTION for reputation there's something that pees us off but we don't hear about that, right?

Metanoia – True repentance

Now, think about God! He can see all your sins, all your thoughts, all your fallen nature; EVERYTHING! In Japan and Korea, we talked about the fact that when we do repentance we turn away. We're not in a game like,

"Oh God, yesterday I did ten bad things. I'm sorry, I'm sorry! I'm so honest! Dear God, I'm telling you about the ten bad things I did last night."

But God said,

"Uh-huh! I saw the 10,000 bad things you did last night boy, or girl!" You can't play that game with God because He can see EVERYTHING; He can see all the sins. So, repentance is not about playing that game,

- "Oh, I'm so holy, I'm so honest to God! I did repentance on the ten sins I did yesterday!"

No, no, no! *Metanoia* means changing of the heart, changing of the mind; TURNING away from sin. Are you with me folks? That means turning away from it. What does it mean? You HATE it! You HATE sin!

See, before repentance you look at sin and you like it; you delight in it. It's pleasures, it's delicacies like the harlot of Babylon abomination that we see in Revelation chapter 18:

3 "---waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies".

9 "---have committed fornication and lived deliciously with her"

You delight in the sin. People have this enjoyment of the sin because of temporary pleasure, temporary dopamine highs etc. But God is saying, "*No if you repent you have to turn AWAY from the sin; turn away*." That means you turn your back on it, you reject it; you HATE it. And you turn towards what? You turn towards God.

So, it's not about, "Oh, I'm so holy because I can mention 300 things bad about myself!" We have a lot of problem with this in the Japanese church, don't we? A lot of Japanese folks come from Buddhism or Shintoism where everything is work-based righteousness, so however many times you do a penance or however many times you do the two claps and then bing-bing, you ring the bell in the Shinto shrines; however many times you did it you're being "purified and sanctified." Especially in certain esoteric forms of Buddhism, if you do a mantra, if you do the chanting of Buddhist texts for that, then while you're chanting, you're a "perfect Buddha." Even though you're out there killing, murdering, raping and committing adultery, when you're chanting you are a "perfect Buddha." This is the theology. In that magical spell of all the mantras and all that, you become perfect? Give me a break! That is mythology; that is ridiculous! That's not only Buddhism; it's Shintoism, animism...

God wants our heart, not rituals

It is very different for those who are followers of Christ, because our relationship with God is not based on rituals. It's not like God sees you reciting Hoon Dok Hae or the Bible or ringing a bell and He says, "Wow! That's my good and faithful son and daughter!' Imagine if you wanted that relationship with your son or daughter, and your son or daughter came up to you in the morning: "Good morning, Daddy!" Bing-bing! Can you imagine how ridiculous that would be? Think about that! You don't even say, "good morning!" Just, "Ommmmment" Bing-bing! Think how frustrated you'd get! "Child, just call me Daddy! Give me a hug!" Are you with me folks?

God is not there for the rituals alone. He has ritual traditions and liturgical traditions, but those are only meaningful if you LOVE Him first. If you already gave your heart to Him, and you do those things to please Him then that's okay, right?

But there are a lot of problems with a lot of first gen raising the second gen too ritualistically. Uh-huh! Many times, they come from Japan or Korea maybe from Shamanism or animism or Shintoism or Buddhism; so, it's all about the ritual. The ritual has the magical power; the ritual is the thing that makes you perfect and makes you a Buddha and makes you a perfect individual or makes you a god or whatever it is, depending on that pagan religion.

It is not that God is after your heart and He really wants You to love Him and He actually wants to have a relationship with you!! NO! That isn't the focus! The focus is RITUALS! *"All my kids have to do HDH every day at 5 am!"* Most of those families, their kids run away because it just becomes rituals; it

doesn't become real. The parents are not interested in the HEART of the CHILD and his relationship with God; they're interested in RITUALS! Ah!

And if you're interested in rituals, guess what? The heart doesn't follow just because of the ritual. Your kids may go through it when they're young and their personality is still openness and agreeableness. When they're young those are the two major personalities for children: openness and agreeableness. That's why pedophiles go after children; because they're open and they're agreeable. Which means what? They lack discernment.

So, your kids may go along with your rituals, may be going to Sunday service. If you grow up in a Methodist or Baptist Church, it's sort of like going to Sunday school or to a summer camp, or in the Catholic Church maybe like going to mass, but it's just ritual.

In the end the God of the Bible is not like the pagan deities, He's not after rituals and people just obeying His ritualistic demands. That's what PAGAN deities may do, and they promise you that through those rituals you'll have power; you'll have magical mystical sorcery and black magic empowerment, etc. But God is not interested in that. God is interested in the heart of the person; He wants a relationship with them.

So, a lot of families focus on the RITUAL aspects. They say, "Well, Father told us we got to do HDH," so they beat it into their kids, "We're going to do HDH. It doesn't matter what you feel." As the kid gets older, a teenager, they have to fight with him every day, and now there's a bitterness in HDH and all this stuff. Of course, they're not thinking about the heart of the child; they're just thinking about how well they can do the rituals and brag to their friends about how well their family does HDH. But guess what? That starts becoming a BURDEN on the children; they start going nuts. They realize, "Oh! Dad and Mom are about ritual; they're trying to use me as a stage prop. I'm NOT really here because I believe it or love Christ; I'm here as a stage prop." This is what it turns out to be, and those families almost always fail because they're not looking at it from God's perspective, not looking at it from changing the HEART- which God wants. He wants our heart!

That's why for example, when we raised our kids, we didn't focus on rituals. Even though we're Father's family, we're in the kingship line, etc., we didn't focus on rituals. That's not the most important thing. The most important thing is trying to witness to our children; evangelize. Parents, as a king and priest, a queen and evangelist, you have the job to evangelize your children; you have to PREACH, you have to LEAD them in a priestly way and you have to try to evangelize them. That doesn't come by just making them do rituals!

Let's say you're witnessing somebody and they say,

- "Oh, sure yeah sure, I'll come to your church."

-" Okay, good, good! So now I'm going to come to your house every day at 4:30 am and we're going to start at 5:00 am, we're going to do HDH EVERY single day, and don't ask questions. We're going to do it for an hour straight without talking!"

Tell me one person who evangelizes that way! Not one! Because that person will be," *Hey! I just said I'm going to come to your church one time. I'm not talking about having you over at 4:30 in the morning. You know what I'm saying? I got to get to work"* - or whatever. Are you with me folks? We would never, never, never, evangelize a person that way, witness to them, pray for them that way! NEVER! We would take the ritual stuff EASY, and we would focus on their heart; praying for their heart, and trying to consult them when they have questions. Are you with me folks? We are worried about the HEART! Is that true? That's how we would evangelize; that's how we would preach the Gospel to anybody.

How come we do not do that with our children? When they're young, up to ten years old or so, their main personality trait is openness and agreeableness, so they WILL DO what you tell them to do. That's why these crazy lefties are trying to brainwash the kids when they're like five years old and hypersexualize them; putting this transgender abuse ideology into their minds so they can PROFIT off them; giving them hormones like LUPONE which brings chemical castration, and destroying their lives. I'm not going to get into that; go watch the movie *"What is a woman?"* by Matt Walsh and you'll see. <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=TqBguWbia_o</u>

Oh! Gosh! Crazy! The lefties and the commies, they know they got to get the kids young; why? Because they're open in agreeableness, open in openness. People who are open in openness, usually their discernment is low. People who are high in confrontation they're more competitive; they want to do competitions, things like that.

Children are taught cultural atheism

So, when the child is young, raising them up in the ways of the Lord is essential; not just in the rituals of God or the religion or the church, but in what? The ways of the Lord. How is God? What is He? Also being aware of their surroundings. Most likely they're going to government school, what are they learning? If they're watching online what are they learning? They're learning cultural ATHEISM! They're learning evolution at five years old; big bang at five years OLD! They're learning that God doesn't exist. That this universe doesn't need a God to exist; it is completely capable of evolving and developing on its own without a designer. They're learning cultural atheism from a very young age; they're being brainwashed into cultural atheism, that is to say that God doesn't exist. Also, they're "studying" biology, geometry, physics and everything else.

Now they're coming home and saying, "I don't even believe in God. You're talking to me about God's heart, but I'm not even sure there's a GOD!" See, parents, we have to be aware of that; we have to ADJUST to that. Now you're evangelizing somebody who is an atheist, essentially. You can't say, "You're my SON! *How dare you!*" You can't do that because what would that do? It'll probably strengthen his atheism and that will probably make his life purpose to give you pain by being an atheist; it will give him so much ammunition and purpose, "Look what you've done to me! You scarred me! I'm going to pay you BACK! I'm going to hate God and sleep with all the girls that I want and I'm going to pay you back, Dad or Mom!" You see what I'm saying? It becomes this ridiculous stupid payback game; it's not about relationship any more.

We need to be aware that our kids are going to be brainwashed into cultural atheism; they're brainwashed to HATE God and to doubt God. So just as if we were evangelizing somebody who was a cultural atheist, we have to approach them differently when they start getting hit with those ideologies; it's not effective if they're struggling with God, *"I don't even know if God exists."* They're never going to tell you that, but you just have to know that that's what their friends are talking about, that's what YouTube is always talking about, that's what every government school is teaching them. They're not going to tell you because they're scared of getting in trouble with Mom and Dad, but it is just the way it is. They're going to be cultural atheists. So, they've become teenagers and now they're trying to learn discernment; they're trying to figure out, *"Whom can I trust my parents? Can I trust my parents? Can I trust my teacher? Whom can I trust to find my way through this world?"* Well, at that point you have to be AWARE of where they're at. Amen!

You have to be aware that when you're talking to them about spiritual things you're talking to a cultural atheist. You can't just jump into Genesis and jump into Moses and Noah's Ark which they believe is a JOKE of a myth because they see those Bible Sunday school books with the small little boat with all those big animals on it. That's their conception of Noah's ark; it's a parody of what the actual Bible describes about Noah's ark.

So, at the time they're teenagers they think this is stupid, "Dad, Mom, you're talking about Noah's Ark; you're talking about Moses who probably didn't even exist." And probably they're going to go into all the atheist arguments; different scholars that say, "Well, the Exodus doesn't match up in terms of time; the Exodus comes way later and we have no archaeological evidence of ISRAELITES even living in Egypt." Anyway, this is what the atheists say. There are other Christian scholars who have tons of evidence that show, "NO! There actually IS a time period when Jews ARE in Egypt AND it matches up with the different periods of Egyptian history." There's a whole field of apologetics here, a huge, huge field of apologetics, but I am not an expert in THAT particular apologetic field.

The point is: you're dealing with a child who has cultural atheism as his main religion. Even though he doesn't call it religion it is a religion in his mind; it's his dominant form of thinking and worship. Then if you're evangelizing that kind of person, you can't approach them by talking about Jesus and Acts chapter 5. It doesn't make sense because they're struggling with," *Is there a God?*" So, it's better for those kids in that period of time to start studying, "*Oh! Is there a God? Are there any good arguments for God?*" Let's listen to the atheistic arguments and let's listen to the theistic arguments, i.e., the Godcentric arguments. Are there good arguments, are there good REASONS to believe in God? Is it truly unscientific? Is it truly irrational? Is it truly that, if you're low IQ then you believe in this kind of stuff? Is that TRUE?

Well, it's interesting that the head scientist, the founder of the human genome, he is a believer in Christ, and he has a Mensa IQ of probably about 200. So, one by one as you study these things with your children, you start approaching them where they're at; not where you want them to be. We all know that when you are parents you want your child to be perfect in every phase of life. That's what you want; it's not what you're going to get. Amen!

But I GUARANTEE you're not going to get that! No way! Why? Because your child is going to go through a journey. He/she's also going to struggle; he/she's also going to get tempted by the Devil. He also is going to be called to leave God, to hate God, thinking God is a big joke; she the same. And for the parents as the priest and evangelist of that community, that small community we call family, it is incumbent upon us to be effective when we evangelize. Amen!

But we didn't see it as evangelism! We just thought, "*Oh, just listen; just do the rituals, and they will all turn out, they'll never fall.*" But 90 plus percent of the "blessed children' fell, slept around, had sex out of wedlock. All those things that the first gen BELIEVED would never happen ALL happened, and not only in small numbers; the vast MAJORITY fell, VAST majority! Why? Because we just thought they would be good little robots, they would just follow the rituals and they're just going to be perfect little children. THAT is ridiculous! That's not even a Principled mindset, it's just a lazy mindset, honestly speaking; it's lazy, it's not even principled.

Look at atheistic & theistic arguments

In the Principle, we explain how God doesn't want robotic people or relationships. I remember the dang lecture with the freaking robot coming out and all that kind of stuff. Give me a break! It said it in the Principle! Some of these people teach it in the Principle, and yet they are trying to make their kids into a robot. Your kids are not going to follow along with God because you just make them do rituals; no way! Our job as priest and evangelist is to help them BUILD a relationship with God. That doesn't mean by just TELLING them what they have to believe; it means by helping them navigate.

"Okay, you're influenced by cultural atheism, so let's look at some of the atheistic arguments; let's look at them." Why aren't parents doing that? "You know cultural atheism, that's pretty big in the young people's world. Let's look at some of those arguments; let's look at them and let's see if they're stronger than the theistic arguments." How come we didn't do that? We said, "How DARE you not believe in God! Don't you know how much GOD has given to you? DON'T you know how much we've been THROUGH because of God? We would never have MET if it wasn't for God; you would never be BORN if there was no God!" Okay, all right, so what's that child supposed to say? "Okay, I give up! I give up!" Give me a break! All he's going to do is just not talk about it to you anymore, but he's going to harbor an inner resentment towards God, because when he was trying to SEEK God even though it was the wrong way and probably led by culturally atheism, there was nobody to guide him. The parents just said, "NO! You just have to do this," but there was no guidance.

There was no, "Okay, okay, let's see! In the young people's world nowadays, you know transgenderism is big. All right, let's see if there are actual good arguments. Let's go and listen to their arguments." That's the whole thing about the Matt Walsh movie, "What is a Woman?" He goes and TALKS to these crazy idiots; he goes and talks to these top PHDs who are profiting BIG time over trans abuse. That means they're helping children sex reassign at four or five years old and they're making TONS of money. They're giving them puberty blockers which is the big drug called Lupron, a drug they actually give to sex offenders to chemically CASTRATE them! They're giving that Lupron drug to CHILDREN, which is crazy! This is the same drug you're giving to sex offenders, people who rape children; you're giving it to them to CASTRATE them, and you're giving that to KIDS! Are you kidding me? Of course, the doctor didn't want to talk about this, *"I'm done with this interview."* She's making money off this, folks; money!

So, what is he doing? From their own mouth he's exposing the ideologues, some of the top scholars of this trans lunacy. Basically, the trans ideology hangs itself; it's not founded on reality so they have to back themselves in a corner and make even more outrageous claims. We got to do a movie night here in Tennessee too. Amen! Where we can watch "2,000 Mules" and we all come down here and have some popcorn and some kombucha or whatever.

The point is: in those kinds of videos, you see these guys are going and they're trying to talk to the top ideologues. They're trying to show you a case like, "Look we talked to the top people in this ideology and they're CRAZY. They can't keep this on. When you press them, 'Oh, he can become a girl; gender is fluid,' when you press them, press them, and press them, they have to make more OUTRAGEOUS claims." He asked,

- "So, if a chicken is laying an egg is that a female chicken?"

And the doctor answered,

- "Well, it could be."

-" You're a doctor right, you're a doctor; you're a PHD. So, when we see a chicken laying an egg, we cannot say it is a female chicken?"

Anyway, it's just kind of a lunacy. When you see the video, you'll see how RIDICULOUS it is; it's SO ridiculous! If you haven't seen it, go subscribe to Matt Walsh on YouTube.

He breaks this down in his own videos. He's phenomenal. He is probably one of the top activists on the side of reality attacking this ideology head first. He's very intelligent, he's very smart and he dissects it. He tries to debate these people and of course they always run away, backed up in the corner and declare, *"I'm done with this interview,"* as they always do.

So, when the child is in teenage years, it's not like, "Okay, you're going to do summer camp and you're going to read the Bible TEN TIMES straight from cover to cover, because when I was young the Holy Spirit hit me and I read my bible TEN TIMES so now you're going to do it!" They're in a situation that is totally different from yours back then, and also, they've been brainwashed from five years old that there is no God and evolution is king; they've been brainwashed by the Big Bang and all that kind of stuff, and that according to the nature of the universe we don't need any designer. They've been brainwashed with this without challenges many times for a decade. We have to understand that when they hit the teens, we're dealing with somebody who has about a decade worth of brainwashing in cultural atheism. So, when we're dealing with that kind of person, we have to deal with them skillfully. We don't just deal with them like,

- "You're WRONG!"

- "Why am I wrong?"

-" Because I said so!" or "You're wrong because the Bible says so!"

They don't even believe in the Bible! At that point you can't even point to it as an authority. They are cultural atheists and in order to work with a cultural atheist what do you do? "Okay, well let's look at the arguments for atheism. Then let's contrast that and let's look at the arguments for theism. Are there good arguments for theism?"

It's going to be a journey. There's going to be resistance, there's going to be kicking and screaming soto-speak inside the spirit, because now they have to confront for the first time in their life, the cult and the social atheism that they've been indoctrinated with for the last TWELVE years. Now for the first time in their life they have to look at it and actually start critiquing it, and if Daddy and Mommy can help them do that lovingly...

But there's no guarantee! There's never any guarantee in life; there's no guarantee. There's no guarantee that you leave church this Sunday and you don't get hit by a Mack truck and die; there's no guarantee but there's low probability. Same with raising children. There's no guarantee that everyone will be saved, that everyone will choose Christ BUT there are probabilities. If you evangelize them skillfully you can raise the chance, the probability that they open their heart towards God. Why? Because they felt their PARENTS were SERIOUS about THEIR journey in finding GOD, and not just cramming it down the throat saying, "Do a ritual boy, and make me look good in front of everybody else! I did twenty years of HDH with my children." You go meet the kids; they're all like," Whoa! What happened to you, kids?" Man! They can't even look at people in the eyes; they're like hunched back. Lord, have mercy!

NO! Evangelism is different! You have to help them create a relationship with God. That takes a little work on the parents' part. That's why it's not going to be done by osmosis; it's not going to be done naturally, because they're living in the satanic world.

Learning from consequences to stupid behavior

This is why God gave us freedom. Freedom allows people to choose BAD, but by seeing people choose BAD we see what? We see the consequences and that's a BIG point of learning.

We see Ananias and Sapphira, they chose bad! They tried to deceive to boost their REPUTATION, and God was angry and they died. So, we say," *Oh shoot! Okay, there are consequences to stupid behavior.*" That's a very important thing. If the world was all perfect and nobody ever made a mistake, you would never LEARN, you would never realize that your actions have consequences. But that's the thing with freedom; with freedom people can choose bad decisions, so then you have a case study. You see with your own eyes, "*Oh my Gosh! If you get addicted to alcohol like that, man, you're going to turn out like him.*"

That's why we didn't drink a sip of alcohol. Why? Our eldest brother, Hyo Jin-hyung, he was an alcoholic; when he was young, he was molested by one of the leaders, so his life was ruined. He wanted to commit suicide and everything; he was a WRECK his whole life. I didn't even know about it until he died; Kook Jin-hyung told me later that he was molested as a child. This wrecked his whole life and he became an alcoholic, drug addict, everything; went to prison multiple times. As youngins

we saw him behaving like that and we were like, "Dang! Ah-ah no, I'm not going to drink. You're going to turn out like him? No! I'm not drinking, not doing drugs; I'm not going to drink because I don't want to turn out like him. I see what he's doing. He's destructive, he's scary; every relationship is falling apart, etc."

That's the thing with freedom; with freedom people can choose bad decisions, and we actually learn. We see them and say, "Whoa! Man! I'd better not do that." We are like, "Oh shoot! I'd better not do like that person who believed they could fly," (Singing) "I believe I can fly," and he jumped off the dang bridge and he's dead! Then you realize, "Oh shoot! Just because you BELIEVE you can fly doesn't mean you can." Are you with me folks? So, you learn that there are consequences to behaviors and there are consequences to actions, and this is very important.

Parents as trained guides

Same thing with our kids! When they're going through that difficult stage when they're really questioning their faith, nobody else can do it; it's really the parents that have to do it. Parents have to step in as a king and evangelist and be GUIDING them through that time, lovingly, gently. Many times, when they're teens, kids get very sensitive. They feel disrespected very easily because they don't have a lot of competencies so they feel inadequate. They're just starting to try to learn discernment; they know they've been naive in the past so they're trying to BUILD up more confidence. That's why they're many times hypersensitive, so one has to be very sensitive with them. At that period of time, you come too hard, what happens? They flip, they can go wacky, they can commit suicide, they can do stupid stuff. The Devil can lure them to do STUPID stuff. Suicide being murder, you're MURDERING yourself; the self that God gave you, you're murdering it, you're killing it. That's reality, right?

At that stage dealing with that kid like an evangelist as if we were witnessing somebody is very important, very important, and it's the parents that have to do it because they're the closest ones. The church can't do it, the pastors can't do it; the elders can't do it. No, it's the parents that have to do it; that's the front line in that small community called the family. Are you with me, folks? Amen! That's why it's so important for the parents to be studying these apologetics things, studying basics of counseling. That's why we're going to get the young kings and young queens in on this training. Your children are going to get through it in the teenage years, definitely, so you will need the basics of counseling, basics of helping somebody, evangelism, basics of apologetics.

At that point when they're in struggle, having their parents EVEN just INTRODUCING the idea of, "Yeah, there are arguments for atheism and arguments for theism." Just by introducing that, that can be a MASSIVE change in the destiny of their life. Just because the parents didn't say like, "Oh, you stupid child, what are you doing? The DEVIL has got into you, and now you're going to …" He's struggling in his faith so if you go too hard what happens? It fortifies him and creates an emotional scar and makes him angry and he wants to revenge," Now I'm going to show you Dad and Mom; I'm going to PAY you BACK! The way you hated me; I'm going to hate you the rest of my life. I'm going to screw it up and I'm going to destroy it just to SPITE YOU!" Right? Young people are stupid like that; they can quickly get into those emotions and the Devil of course can lead them, "Yes! Good! Yes!" They can do that quickly.

We don't want to do that. When we are training with our kids when they're teens, we want to be aware where they're at, and that's why the one-on-one day time is so important. From a young age you're creating the foundation one-on-one day time and when they hit the teens you can feel where they're at, *"What is your belief system?"* You can feel, *"What types of influences are you getting in your belief system? Let Daddy and Mommy feel that out. Let's talk about it; let's pray about it."* You see what I'm saying? That's a point of counseling then, through that process of time, and parents being patient and believing that God will lead their child; not getting too anxious, not getting too neurotic.

If you see that your kids in the teenage years don't want to listen to you any more, that's because ten years ago every time they reached out the parents did not respond; there was no response where the child could feel, *"I could trust these people."* So, usually in the teens it starts manifesting as rebellion. But if you've been there with your children, you've been counseling them and you've been building that one-on-one relationship with them, even in their teens there's not a big rebellion stage because you've been talking through things the whole time; you've been counseling them the whole time. Are you with me, folks?

But usually, parents don't do that so then "all of a sudden" they feel, "*Hey, what's up with you? You've changed; what's wrong with you now boy? How come you're changing so much?*" No! No! That boy's been reaching out to his daddy or mommy for the last TEN YEARS! But they've been just saying, "*No! You have no faith! Satan is coming into you, etc.*" And that starts breaking down what? The TRUST that they have in the parents, and then the trust they have in whom? GOD! You see what I'm saying? That's a problem.

See, NOW it's starting to hurt God because the parents didn't pay attention to parenting; they didn't train, they didn't study parenting. Parenting is a skill just like Jiu-Jitsu is a skill. You're not born with it; you don't know it naturally. You actually have to fight all your emotions, especially as your children get older and they get a little more challenging. You have to fight ALL your emotions, ALL your neuroticism, ALL your anxiety when you're counseling and leading them through it. You have to have dominion over your emotional realm, especially the moms.

Moms, your personality traits from the main psychology statistical studies show that women are higher in what? Agreeableness and what? Neuroticism! That anxiety, that's not bad because you keep babies alive when they're young; since women are more anxious about the baby's health and cleanliness the baby has a higher chance of survival. God made it that way. But as the child grows that level of anxiety has to be cut and checked. The moms have to be very CAUTIOUS that you are not projecting that anxiety onto your child, because it will start SUFFOCATING them especially boys; it will start KILLING them, killing, killing, killing them!

Young kings trained for parenting

So, we have to be aware of these things in advance. When we're aware of this in advance we're much better-equipped to deal with them when they come down the line. That's why the training is very important. So, we're getting through the training with Shiggy, Victor Moon and Shinman and then those boys will have groups and they will train the other young kings. In this round we're going to do the young kings and get them involved in parenting. Why?

If you young kings are not involved, apparently guess what? 70 plus percent of women after the first baby feel more depressed, and they also feel less satisfied in marriage. Did you know that? 70 plus percent! Why? They did all the studies, and I told this many times. Was it because they were black or they were white? Was it because one was rich and one was poor? Was it because the husband or the wife was handsome or good-looking? It had nothing to do with any of that. It doesn't matter if you're rich or poor, it doesn't matter if you are white, black or Asian; it doesn't matter.

Why were 70% of the women more unsatisfied in marriage? Why were 30% MORE satisfied with marriage? Well, when they looked at the studies and they focused in on the 30% that were HAPPIER, guess what? Every single one of the women had husbands who were involved in parenting; that means they had an interest in parenting, so the woman didn't feel like she's alone. Are you with me folks? Because when you're dealing with your first baby you don't know what you're doing. You don't know how to hold it, you don't know how to burp it, you don't know how to clean a diaper; everything is sloppy, everything is bad- almost! You may have a good heart about it but everything is white-belt level. It's just the way it is.

The woman feels alone then she feels depressed, no support; the husband is out there making money. But "why isn't he helping with the life of this child or the future of this child?" You see what I'm saying? Then it turns into resentment and anger and fighting, and then she doesn't want to have romance or intimacy with the husband anymore; then he gets upset and he gets all frustrated, etc. and now adultery comes in. Oh Lord have mercy! It's a BIG jamboree of Satan playing around. Are you with me folks?

We don't want that to happen in God's home. Amen! That's why the young kings being involved in parenting, being aware of parenting and some of the pitfalls that come up in the different age periods is very important. It's very, very empowering when you know it beforehand. And guess what? The fact that the young boys are training in this ... I ask their wives, *"Hey! You girls like it that these boys are training?"* They all go, *"Thank you! Thank you!"* They're so happy. Why? Because they're not in it alone. Their husband is not only working for money; he's not just a mule making money. No! He loves his home, he loves his kids, he loves his wife; he loves God's family and he's involved. He's actively learning, he's actively studying in preparation for the realities that will occur along the way, and he's preparing for those things.

Just like you would prepare with martial arts' training. There are certain realities of physical violence so in preparation for that you want to study arts that are real, helpful: Jiu-Jitsu, wrestling, boxing,

Muay Thai. They are real fighting arts in preparation for the potentiality of violence. Same thing! The young kings will be trained in preparation for how Satan will attack their family. Amen! So, they'll be ready for it before it hits. That doesn't mean they're going to be perfect at it, that doesn't mean they're always going to win, but the probability goes up. Some are quicker to learn these things and some are slower. Just like fighting. Some pick it up real fast, some people real slow, but even though you pick it up real slow, it's better than not having it at all. You're still WAY higher level than if you never learned it. Amen!

It's all about the heart

So, having that training is so, so, so, important because that's how the Devil is going to shake you up, trying to destroy your marriage, to destroy your relationship with your children, because if he can do that, he's going to reduce the possibility that they connect to God with the heart. Amen!

And that's what's so important! God wants to see the transformation of the heart; the heart, the spirit. **He wants to see FREE men and women give their lives to Him because they love Him;** not because they're doing rituals or not because they're told to do so, but because they've decided, "You know what? I've tried my way and it has not been good. I've tried to be my own God and I failed many times and been backstabbed many times and I have many, many scars to show for it. But GOD ALMIGHTY wiped away every tear from my eye and took away all my pain. Why? Because I TURNED away from sin, TURNED away from the idolatry of myself and I said, 'God, You're in control! I give my life to You freely, freely, out of choice because You sacrificed so much for me; You bled and died so that I could be free, and I'm grateful for that and I want to make You HAPPY."

Wow! It's so simple, it's so simple; it's so simple! But at the same time, it's very complex. Most things of high complexity actually are quite simple, but they're also quite complex. Is that true, some of the mechanics and the brothers who know how to deal with very complex machinery? It's actually quite imaginatively simple but highly detailed, highly specific, right? Amen!

Same thing! This is why it's so important to be able to be training like this. So that when our young couples of the second generation are raising up their kids, they are EQUIPPED, they're PREPARED and they're ready with EXCITEMENT and JOY to fight the good fight and to be victorious for God and Christ. Not for their own glory but **for God and Christ!** And uplift the values of the Kingdom and have strong POWERFUL marriage relationship, POWERFUL relationship with their children; giving glory to God together. Peace Police-Peace Militia helping to love God and love our neighbor, being strong protectors, being good whole-hearted people who turned away from sin and know that we were saved by grace.

What a great God we serve! What a loving God we serve!

In the end folks, that's what we're talking about in Acts chapter 5. God struck those two down because they were trying to deceive for reputation. That's why for example a lot of pastors' families get wrecked because the spotlight is on them. All the people are watching their kids so the kids have EXTRA pressure. They have EXTRA pressure because not only do they have to pretend that they're faithful to their parents, but they have to pretend that they're faithful to EVERYBODY else in the community. So as a priest of the home if you're aware of that and you're actually leading a community you have to help your children; talk to them about these things and say, *"Oh, Daddy understands where your heart is because I lived through it too."* I lived through that, under a lot of pressure as a *"true" child* in Father's family; from a young age we were in front of cameras all the time and all that.

But as my kids were growing, I always explained this stuff to them; I opened my heart to them. I would share these inner things I don't share with anybody. I would tell them. Why? Because I wanted them to know my heart. I wanted them to know how I FELT living in a fish bowl in front of cameras all the time, and being a fake prop when you didn't even believe in it. You know what I'm saying? I opened my heart up and I wanted them to understand that they're not crazy, they're not weird for feeling those things. I FELT it too! I went through it too! Are you with me folks? When you're evangelizing somebody, you got to also testify, share your testimony, share why, and that's very important, very important, because it's all about the heart, folks. The rituals? If we give our heart to God, yes! When people who love God are in those rituals, it can make God very happy. But the rituals themselves?

Child better than painting

Do you think a painter just likes the painting, or he likes his child better than the painting? Huh? Which one? He likes his baby boy, baby girl better than the painting.

Leonardo da Vinci painted the *Mona Lisa*, but do you think Leonardo looking at that woman said, "*Oh*, *you*'*re beautiful?*" if he was a normal person and not a psychopath? Many of these artists are psychopaths; they're quite twisted and they end up committing suicide. But let's say he's a normal person and he made this beautiful painting, what do you think he's going to be more impressed with? I'm sure those artists they just look at a leaf on a tree and they say, "*Wow! That's so much better than my painting!*"

Many of these artists live in narcissism, hedonism; they're into sex with all their models, so they're very depraved. A lot of the artists in the world are VERY depraved! They're just in it for hedonism and pleasure. So, if they're like that then they may hate their children, literally hate them, *"You take my freedom; you're such a burden!"* This kind of inner hatred towards their children, this inner hatred of responsibility and faithfulness to the next generation! They've already given that up on the altar of hedonism, pursuing "creativity" and the next model that they're going to have sex with. Which is pathetic; they're nothing more than dung beetles! (*Laughing*)

But think about it: any of those artists if they have a heart, they're going to see that and they're going to see their child and say, *"Wow! My child is so much better than that painting!"* Obviously! Same with God! God may be the greatest artist; He built this world; He made all our faces different and everything. But still, what He likes best is if we love Him; we're His children and we love Him. Wow! It's so simple but it's also so hard!

GOD is our spiritual Father

So, training our kids or evangelizing them is to help that person as best we can -we're not perfect but as best we can- to build that relationship with God. Amen! Very important!

That's what of course we're seeing in this passage: don't seek deception for reputation! Remember in the first gen culture too, remember when people would evangelize somebody, they would want to be their spiritual father or mother? They would FIGHT over them, *"It's MY name on that sheet! I witnessed that person!"* Are you crazy? What the heck is wrong with you people? What are you doing? Why are you trying to take glory for what God has done? Clearly God has done the work in that person's heart. You are not God. We can only try to encourage; we can't actually penetrate into the heart and transform it. Why are you trying to put your name on that person? It was just such a crazy thing! It became too petty; people literally fighting, *"My name should be under this person; that was my number!"* Are you kidding me?

Come on! That's not what God is about!

We want to see souls SAVED!

We want people to fall in love with GOD!

We want them to know CHRIST!

We want them to be EXCITED about living courageously in the midst of persecution and the world hating you!

We want them to live COURAGEOUSLY!

We don't want to be fighting over whose name and who gets to be their spiritual father and mother! Come on! Come on! Hello! The spiritual Father is God! Hallelujah! ALL praise goes to God! We just stood by there and tried to help along the way a little bit; that's about it. We very clumsily helped along the way; we don't get to take that credit.

So, it grows more into this kind of ridiculous stuff; it becomes deception for reputation, "*I witnessed ten people this year*. *I have my name on five people this year*!" You're crazy! You clearly don't care for God's heart here. People don't get to be your number. It's God to whom they go to, not to us. Amen! This is deception for reputation, "*PRAISE ME! I have my name on ten of the new people!*" How about, "*Go jump in the lake*!" Huh?

You see what I'm saying? It turns into this ridiculous deception for reputation, and God hates that! He HATES that! He hates that! Think about the toxicity of that; if that's allowed in the church, how toxic that becomes! You get the craziest psychopathic people then gathering and chasing all the kindhearted people away; it becomes a club of very strange people who want to put their number on everybody. What is wrong with you people? No, no, no, no! GOD gets the glory. Amen!

God gets the glory, then everybody's free. Okay, you participate a little bit here and there but God gets the glory. Thank God! "Father thank You so much for doing that. We tried to help along the way. I know we're stupid, we're imperfect, we're clumsy, but my goodness You are SO good Father! Thank You, Lord!" You

see how much more beautiful that is! That's a lot more love focused in the proper direction, and in that atmosphere then the Holy Ghost can come. Amen! The Holy Spirit can come; He can dwell and Father can be happy. Praise God!

Well, we were going to study Exodus chapter 32 today, we were going to study Daniel chapter 4 today, but I think we're running a little bit over time; we got to get to "Bullets and BBQ." We'll get to that maybe next week.

The point is: God hates, hates, hates, this kind of thing, trying to deceive for reputation! That is not our God. We are not seeking **our reputation; we toss that away when we serve Christ**. We live for something other than money, power, reputation, fame etc. We live for His will, His glory and His Kingdom.
