The King's Position

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Thank you, King Gregg. Shout out to all the folks! Let's give it up for all our staff, volunteers, all the folks that helped for the Third King's wedding! (*Applause*) That was tremendous. Shout out to all of you folks that participated, helped and of course all the support from around the world.

I always tell Shin-Joon, "Remember the king's position is the place where you're hated on the most. You're blamed for everything, you're hated on; it's a place of people's envy and people's anger etc. It's not a place of glory, it's a burden. But that training is not because you wanted to do it, it's not because you decided to do it; it's because God chose you for that purpose and it is a part of your job to be obedient to that."

Our brothers and sisters who love Father they show love, but the world hates you; they hate you the most. The world is constantly attacking. Therefore, one of the key things is to always remember, "Don't chase the world's fame and fortune and things like that. Those things are ephemeral, they're impermanent; they're transient. But always you must chase the joy of the Father and be loyal and righteous in the eyes of God." That doesn't mean self-righteous.

True Father & the Danbury Training

Of course, I told Shin-Joon that his training begins and he will be doing the Danbury training that we did in serving Father when we first started in the priesthood. The Danbury training, it's an active prayer, meditation and practice; Danbury training was part of our daily morning training. This was before Father made me world president. I was at a small church in Mapo. If you heard the song, "Thank you Father," you heard that bar about preaching in Mapo. https://rumble.com/v26tmzq-king-bullethead-thank-you-father-official-music-video.html

There was a little church in Seoul with maybe seventy people or something like that, and I started ministry there. I started to actually preach in Korean which was very difficult because I was born in America and English is my mother tongue. The people were very patient with me there. Oh Lord! Every week I had to practice like twenty times before I spoke because I got to do this in another language, in Korean. Even though I was basic in Korean, that didn't mean I could do a dang sermon in Korean; just because you are basic in another language that's a totally different ball game.

We did the Danbury training and then Father promoted me to 본부교 - Bonbugyo which was the old Chongpadong Headquarters Church. So, he moved me from Mapo to 본부교 - Bonbugyo and of course from then on to other big responsibilities. The point was that every morning in our training I would have a group of *Hoonsanims* -you've probably met Kim Hoonsanim. They were retired ministers; I had invited the ministers that had retired, "You can come and train with me in the morning."

I would meet them on Maebongsan mountain. Korea is very mountainous, even Seoul City; if you've been to Korea, you know it's very mountainous. The city is in between the mountains. Every day I would meet them at 2:30 am on the mountain and we would hike up the Maebongsan. There we would do our morning exercise; we would do two hours of contemplative prayer and meditation up and we'd come down. Then we had to hit *Hoondokhae* at the 본부교 – Bonbugyo, and after a one-hour *Hoondokhae* we'd do the Danbury training. So, right after *Hoondokhae* we'd hit the bathrooms.

The whole purpose of the Danbury training is to reflect on Father's suffering course. Whenever Father was imprisoned, guess what? Father chose the worst and nastiest place to sleep. Remember, in Hungnam prison there were twenty, thirty guys in one cell and there was one open toilet which was a hole in the ground. It was not like the Western toilets with a seat; it was a dang hole in the ground. It was the level of the Vietnam Rambo movie prison. This was North Korea; right before the Korean War, they had the economic level of Nigeria. People forget that; it was extreme poverty, Nigeria's economic level.

Father purposely chose to sleep where all the prisoners didn't want to sleep which was where? It was next to the shish kebab hole, the big poop hole. That's where Father slept. Father wrote about it in the autobiography; he wrote about that. He said that nobody wanted to sleep there. The prisoners would eat just a little bit of a rice ball per day; they were all malnourished, sickness was rampant, and a lot of people had diarrhea constantly. So, nobody wanted to sleep next to the hole because they splattered everywhere.

It's like walking into a porta potty. You all know how a porta potty looks like after a day of heavy use. Imagine after years of use and never getting cleaned how that thing would look. You understand how nasty that is going to be; it's totally nasty even after a day or a week. You leave a porta potty for a week with heavy use, thirty, forty people using it a day, it's going to get

nasty; is that right? But imagine if it never gets cleaned. It's like sleeping on feces; which we were doing here in Cheongpyeong sleeping on the donkey feces. But that's different, that's dried up; it's getting sun-dried. In the prison cell no sun was coming in; there was no sun drying it out. It was nasty, bacteria-laden, and guess what? Nobody wanted to sleep there.

But Father said, "I will sleep there." This is the Lord. Do you understand? He said, "I will sleep near the poop hole." And every time somebody had to run over there and do a nasty diarrhea splattering and splattering everywhere, the Lord of the Second Advent would lay there, and what would he do? He would give thanks to God for training him; he would give thanks! You understand what I'm saying? That's insane! That's ridiculous! That's not possible! The Danbury training was all about that.

The Old Ministerial Class in Korea vs the *Hoonsanims*

Many of the old ministerial class had become very haughty, they had become highfalutin; they had become arrogant. So, when I got in there, we changed up a lot of things. For example, we discovered that they were pretending to be tithing and they were telling all the brothers and sisters, "You should tithe." They were telling us that they were tithing so we were saying, "Oh, that's good; you're setting a good example." We looked into it, and what was it? They were not tithing. They were paying ten percent of their salary into life insurance, which is not tithing; that's not tithing. You understand?

Tithing doesn't have to do with the amount of money. It doesn't have to do with big salary or small salary. It's the same for a giant salary or a tiny salary; it's the same, the same exactly, because it's a percentage. It's about acknowledging God, that all the blessings come from Him and that God GIVES us the ninety percent. Actually, tithing is all the same for someone making a hundred million and someone making two dollars; it's the same amount. Why? Because it's percentage-based. So, we exposed that the ministers were doing this and we told them, "This is not tithing; you people are lying to your congregation. How are they supposed to respect you if you don't tithe? I've been tithing. I'm the world president; I'm tithing to the church. I've been tithing; all my children tithe. This is not tithing." That was one of the things.

They had become this ministerial crusty bureaucratic class and they had created their own little fiefdoms. We had to restructure; many of them over a certain age retired, and of that group we had a couple of *Hoonsanims*. They were *Moksanims* at first. These are the ones that were truly Abel type; these are the ones that were NOT part of that corrupted weirdo class. The ones that were part of the corrupted class hated us and they didn't want us to do anything.

But those who thought, "No, no! Father chose his son as world president; even though I was asked to retire I'm not going to hold that personally and I'm still going to try to support him," those were the Hoonsanims. They came in, but they didn't become Hoonsanims right away. They had to train with me four hundred days straight and if they missed three days, they would start back at day

one; that was the training. Of course, it was like a spiritual test, "Can you keep up with me? Will you train and will you humble yourself?" Not before me but, "will you humble yourself before God, before brothers and sisters and everybody?"

So, we did the Danbury training which was unheard of. The ministerial class had become a sort of priestly class that was kind of supposed to be worshiped, and now all of a sudden, the world president is freaking cleaning the dang toilets, messing up this whole image and narrative they've created about themselves. Now, I'm the highest minister under Father, I'm the highest minister; I'm the high priest that Father anointed over all these ministers, and what am I doing? Every day I'm cleaning the toilets and I'm making all my ministers in that church and under me do it. You understand?

For years they have received praise and have had privilege and special treatment. But I don't want to play that game, "I'm not here to please you, ministerial class; I'm not here to please you." This is kind of like the Deep state; I'm not trying to be here to please the Deep State or this bureaucracy, "You are not God!" I'm here to give honor and make my father happy. So, of course they're angry; their lips come out like this. That's what we say in Korea when people get angry, grumbling under their teeth, mumbling under their breath. They are all angry at what we're doing.

And of course, Kook J-Hyung is cleaning up the 재단, the Jaedan, the foundation, the businesses and he's firing the ones that are corrupt. He's bringing all the new systems and an electronic system of decision making, so no leader can say, "I never made that decision," and not take responsibility for it. You see, it's electronic; it was an electronic system that Kook J-Hyung brought in. He brought a Samsung and LG group, he brought in all these accountants and lawyers etc., and he brought in that system. He told them to bring that, "I want that system in for the business group." We eventually brought it into the church group, so that no person in position of authority could say,

"I didn't know about it. I didn't make that decision."

-" Your name was signed right here electronically at 10: 52 am on November 17th. It's right there. Your name and your signature are right there, see?"

It got sent to him, he was the only one that could sign it and then it moved up the chain of command until if it was on the church side I signed it, or if it was on the business side Kook Jin Nim signed it. So, we brought in all these huge systems and checks and balances etc.

The ministerial class had been used to pride and privilege for thirty years or something like that; it was so ridiculous. They were like this big lobby group for one another, and they would get up and talk about how hard their life was. It was basically an unspoken agreement amongst the ministerial class that, "Whenever you speak publicly, just remind everybody how HARD the minister's life is." This was the game; they were trying to create a pity party all the time for their group.

We came in and started wrecking it. We said, "You're not going to play pity party. Why do you have a pity party about yourselves? We're not coming here to worship you. Father made us do a job; we're not here to worship you. We're here to spread the Gospel. This church is not about you; it's about spreading the Gospel. Father's Word has to expand. More people have to be saved; they have to be blessed. We have to start bringing fruit." They didn't like that because they didn't have to witness, they didn't have to bless; they didn't have to do anything and they would get that payment. It's just like the Deep State; that's how the Korean leadership set it up. So, we went in there and we started to basically wreck it.

Towards the ones that retired I thought, "Let me extend an olive branch," since basically we made them step down. After a certain age you should step down and let a new age of ministers come in. Of course, we felt sad about that because many times they'd been doing ministry for thirty, forty, fifty years. Therefore, I said, "For the ministers who have retired, we invite you to do the jeongseong, the sincerity training with the world president." Out of that group a few couples came in and these three couples are the ones that remained. Others came in and they didn't last so long. But these folks, the 김갑용 훈사님 부부 Kim Kabyong Hoonsanim couple, the 김용력 Kim Yongryuk Hoonsanim couple and the 서유암 Seoh Yu-ahm Hoonsanim couple, those are the couples (The wives are Hoonsanims as well), the three families who remained and made it through the four hundred days. They were in their sixties and I was very strict. There was no excuse; even if you were sick you had to come in. If you missed three days out of four hundred, you had to go back to day ONE! You had to start at day ONE, and of course their wives as well.

목사님 *Moksanim* is a traditional way to say reverend or minister in Korean, but we had a new name 훈사님 *hoonsanim*, it's like a training minister. That's what it means. It's the same 훈 *hoon* as *hoondokhae*, *hoon* which means like training. It's also the same as 훈련 *hoonlyeon* which literally means training; it's the same character. So, the *Hooonsanims*, these three couples made it through that training, and boy, they stayed so loyal.

Every day, we would do the *hoondokhae*, we would do the Danbury training; we'd do all that. I had a lot of time to pour into them and for them to understand that up till then what the ministers had been doing, that was an archangelic type; that was a Cain type. Now Father had chosen his son, and his son that he put in responsibility, in the providential language would be the Abel side. That now they could not rely on the past, on what the Cain-type leaders had told them to do, but they had to adjust to what the Abel son was telling them to do and guiding them on what kind of culture we should have. So, these folks right here, these are the ones, these three families!

Remember after the Han mother and all that craziness happened in a wilderness course period, guess which ministers stood up? For them it was a no-brainer. It was the *Hoonsanims*. All three couples just boom! They knew immediately this was wrong and from the very beginning after the Han mother's fall, they stood with True Father's Three Kingship. Let's give it up for the *Hoonsanims*! (*Applause*)

The point is: every day we would do the Danbury training which was cleaning-the-toilet training and we got some good old fun in there. Man, it would be fun! We got six people in there and myself and we were running around in the bathroom mopping up everything; we were singing in the bathroom with the smell of Lysol everywhere. It was quite enjoyable to do that training. Of course, before and after we prayed, but the point to remember is that it was contemplative training, "Remember the attitude of Father in prison. We get to clean the poopy of saved people, Father had to clean the poop of killers, murderers and prisoners etc. So, we have no complaint; there's no complaint."

Now, remember, this had never been done in the ministerial class. I could have been the minister just going with the status quo. But I said, "No, I'm not here to please you people, I want to make MY Father smile; that's whom I'm here to please. I'm here to give him joy in any way I can." Of course, since I had made it very clear that basically I wasn't going to be part of their club, their little lobby group, behind the scenes they were always wishing me to fail and die etc.

Father's Heir is Not in a Position of Glory

You have to understand that the position Father choses for his heir is not a position of glory; it's a position that is hated the most. So, you really have to train hard. And even though people who love Father can follow, they also want to see character; that's very important. That's why Shin-Joon, being still young, only eighteen years old, needs to grow a lot more. He's still white belt; blue belt in Jiu-Jitsu but in many other realms he's totally white belt. Therefore, he's going to go training and that Danbury training is an important part of his training.

Also, he's young so he's excited. He wants to get out there and witness and maybe he wants to go make a YouTube channel; those kinds of things would be nice and we can help him develop those things. But of course, he's going to have to start doing Divine Principle lectures; that's always a beginning point. He's still in the study of it but he's going to start lecturing. And he's going to have to start doing home visits and teaching smaller lectures in the homes, getting down to the lowest-level of servant of servant; that's the most important training.

Then, since he's a very neurotic boy, (*Laughter*) he's got to also learn how to control his mind, so his daddy is going to be training him in contemplative prayer meditation training probably two hours a day, so he may have more control over his emotions. He's still young and doesn't have so much control over that at a high level. Better than a normal eighteen-year-old but not at a high level; nowhere near Daddy. He needs to train a lot more.

But it's a wonderful thing because it's not just like we get a position and we do something. No, Father already had approved and he liked the fact that I was a son who liked spiritual training. I was the one who liked to go into caves, stay there overnight and do training and freaking do 10,000 hours of contemplative prayer meditation training and martial arts training. He liked the fact that I was serious about that kind of training. Even though that stuff doesn't lead to

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salvation, it's very important in order to build character, patience and control over your emotions.

Father's Heir Cannot Get Involved

Because in any leadership position the higher you go in any hierarchy the more problems you have to face and the more people will try to tug on you emotionally; people will try to bribe you, people will try to give you this and that. You know what I'm saying? There are all sorts of crazy politics which you cannot get rid of because that's part of human nature and part of human social dynamics; you can never get rid of it. The people who try to actually get rid of it become totalitarians; they become totalitarians and they start centralizing the state. That's what they do; that's what the leftists do. There are certain traits of human nature that you cannot get rid of. Why? Because people have free will.

So, in the position that Father anointed us as heir, many times you have to learn how NOT to get involved. Everybody's always trying to suck you into their battles. I mean we announced, *"Look, if you're under Father's authority, you can start your ministry; it doesn't have to be centralized. You can start a separate ministry; that's fine." Remember this? All of a sudden, we opened it up and said:

* "No, you're not forced to work with people you ABSOLUTELY cannot work with. If you have the unified statement of faith, that Father is the Lord of the 2nd Advent, his chosen heirs and successors are Hyung Jin Moon and Shin-Joon Moon; if you have this basic statement of faith and of course if you have received the blessing and you're under Father's authority, then you can start your chapter your ministry and it's real."

*" But the members are not yours to own; they can move to different churches."

It's not like they live in this area so they have to go to that church. That's common in centralized churches like the Catholic Church etc. But no, the brothers and sisters can move and they can work with the leaders that they want to work with. So, what is that? That's called freedom, but there's also responsibility.

There were a few in Korea and Japan, but probably more in Korea because they were used to a more centralized structure, who said, "Okay, I'm going to do my thing!" (With anger) The whole thing was about how bad this leader was. They built their group up but their level of leadership and character was not high. So, did they last? They didn't last so long, maybe a couple of years, and five, six, seven years later those organizations have collapsed, and a lot of them have come back under the more responsible, more patient, more emotionally-controlled leadership. This is how the world works and that's how hierarchies work. Jordan Peterson always talks about the fact that you cannot get rid of hierarchies; the Left is always trying to get rid of hierarchy but you can't. Hierarchies always existed; they exist in nature everywhere. And eventually there is a hierarchy because God is above us.

But in those relationships, you have all this craziness. So, you had this party saying, "Oh, but we want the Second King to listen to our report. We want him to step in there trying to do this for us." Those were endless by the way; at the time they were endlessly coming. It was not just like once or twice; no, EVERY freaking day. You understand? EVERY day.

"Oh, we would like the Second King to intervene and speak his word on this."

-"NO!!" That was the answer they got. "No! Freedom and responsibility. Be free, be responsible! You're not going to use me to pit me against another group and another group. You're all under Father, you're ALL Father's children, so I'm not going to take your side. You're trying to tug me into this and that little petty battle that you're trying to do like children. NO! You're not getting me in there!" What is this? This is discipline. You have to have this kind of discipline; you can't just get all riled up when a couple of grandmas are pouring their eyes out, crying, "Waaaaahh!" "Okay honey, okay!"

Since you're the representative of Father on the earth you have to speak like the Father, "Yes, I understand that this is painful, bothersome etc., but you have freedom and responsibility and they also have freedom and responsibility. Then work it out; work it out1" We would say that; we would say, "Work it out, just work it out. You're not children here, you're not babies; you're adults. Work it out. Speak to each other judiciously, speak to each other respectfully." The ones that didn't do that and who got on emotional tantrums and stuff like that, their organization has plummeted. You may join that type of organization for a time but you're not going to want to stay there forever, because that organization exists to simply get angry at another organization. It doesn't have any PURPOSE. It just exists out of the charisma of this leader or something like that, and such organization always collapse.

Even though we tell the truth about the Han mother's sin, we KEEP moving forward; we continue moving forward and preaching God's Kingdom and preaching and witnessing and making new blessed families etc. We got to keep pressing FORWARD. Amen! We don't get caught up in the politics or the emotional tantrums of this or that group or whatever they're trying to do. "Okay! Work it out! We're going to keep moving." You see what I'm saying?

Raised in the Palace

The higher you go the more discipline you need to have, because the bigger the error you may make at a higher level, the way larger groups it will impact. So, if you're acting emotionally, if you're pulled by emotions, if people can trick you and manipulate you emotionally and things like this... One of Shin-Joon's weakness is that he was raised under all these women in the Cheon Jeong Gung in Korea. The Han mother is a super-neurotic woman and of all his *onnis* - those are like nannies- none of them cared about the baby; they could have cared less who the hell this child was. You understand? That was not their child. They got that position because of political network and they were trying to use that nanny position to get favors and then get promoted somewhere else. So, they were using him.

But what would they do? They would control the crap on him; EVERYTHING was controlled. He couldn't walk out of the door; everything had to be watched, monitored; everything. Basically, he was living in freaking Alcatraz even though it was a four-hundred-million-dollar palace, and all the kids in the Cheongpyeong region were going to be jealous about that. Which is another reason why I don't like living in big palaces. It's not worth all the hate you get to live in a marble building; it's not worth it. Are you with me folks?

He was under those crazy ladies; the nannies would be changed but they would always dominate him because he was a little baby. They would dominate and control him, so his natural tendency became what? To be submissive to women. Now if you're the king and you are in the position of authority, power and resources, just because a woman tries to manipulate you, you cannot fall prey to that. Do you understand? But boys who grew up in a highly manipulative environment, they have to relearn that, they have to grow over that. They have to understand that they cannot be affected when those types of women try to manipulate them; they can't be affected by that. That's why he needs to train. These kinds of things cannot be overcome simply by just thinking about them. No, you have to actually build new muscles.

One thing about Shin-Joon is that he's very gifted intellectually. But physically, if his daddy didn't train him, he would be a total video game nerd bag that wouldn't want to do any athletics, nothing hard. Why? Because he grew up in the palace in a status of tremendous privilege. Everybody was ready to do everything for him so he did not want to do anything. You understand what I'm saying?

Alpha vs. Beta

He didn't want to do anything hard. Why? Because if you do something hard, you're going to become exposed, you're going to get beat up; the air of holiness is going to be broken and your true level is going to be exposed. That's very hard for kids who grew up in very privileged places. But if you look at the typology of psychopaths and mass killers, guess what? They grew up more privileged? And guess what? Those boys don't want to do anything hard; they never played varsity sports.

That's why when I raised my boys, Shin-Pal and all these boys, it was either American football and wrestling or the Korean military, "That's your choice; you have a choice, but it's going to be alpha male and alpha male." (Laughter) Is that true? And Daddy made them play all that. Why? We all did all that. I played football many, many, years, wrestling, Jiu-Jitsu, boxing, all that stuff. We went through that, so all the boys had to go through that and do that training. Why?

Because the most dangerous thing is a beta male; it's the most dangerous thing. A privileged male, a privileged boy that has done nothing hard, never has done anything difficult where other males beat him up and put him in line; never has experienced real hierarchies that are earned. That is actually guess what? That's the most dangerous male. Those type of males are

the ones that use the women or work with the feminazis to get power and they're the ones that become commies and Lefties.

So, actually the most dangerous individual is not an alpha male. Alpha males are actually quite safe; they create very safe neighborhoods. Now, they're mean to bad stuff. That's why they create a safe place, and a neighborhood that everybody wants to go to and a place where you don't have to WORRY about wackos shooting people up without getting put down quickly. The most dangerous thing is a beta male; a beta male who has never done anything hard, never earned anything and is addicted to media violence.

This was the study on mass shooters by the Army Lieutenant Colonel Grossman who wrote about it in his books *On Killing* and *On Combat*.

He showed the study that all the mass shooters who have killed indiscriminately were addicted to video games, killing video games by the way like *Call of Duty*, addicted to media violence, but at the same time they were privileged and they were weak. They never did anything hard, they never got physical correction from other males. Isn't that interesting? That is literally the typology of the mass shooter. They like violence, they still have all that male desire that when you're angry you want to get violent; they still have that, but they've never actually practiced it and been humble like real males are.

As alpha males you do hard training, you get in the presence of other alpha males and you learn how to bow your head down and get into your place, because you literally are whipped into it. You learn that there's a hierarchy. You learn that the guy you thought you were going to beat because he's this old fat dude and you're trying to fight him, he's freaking strong as heck and one punch by that mallet is like a freaking sledgehammer that will knock your jaw right off. Then you're like, "Holy crap! I better respect fat people!" You learn a lesson. "Whoa! Just because that man was fat doesn't mean ..." You learn, you learn very important lessons that you're never going to learn in the stupid academic intellectual realms. Never! You will never ever learn those lessons there.

That's why those mass killers, they never go through that hard training. That hard training makes you realistic; it makes you understand that you've got to work hard and train hard. If you embrace that it makes you be surrounded by -in terms of the majority, obviously there are bad apples everywhere- by generally a population of males that is quite honest. It doesn't mean they're perfect; many times, they may have other issues, but in certain fields, they're extremely disciplined, extremely capable, extremely honest. I'm not saying in all fields but in certain areas, and you can learn very important lessons from that. That's why all my boys had to train in that, all my boys.

But they naturally want to gravitate beta because Daddy's already tough so they naturally don't want to compete with me there. Then, they want to try to build up their intellectual side, but Daddy is also tough intellectually. "Oh, crap!" So, they try to go this way, "Oh!" and they try to go that way. See, that's how you got to have it; that's how Daddy's got to be and them too. Daddy pushes them to do both kinds of training because their children will do it to them. If Daddy is intellectual, they'll try to go physical and try to beat him up. But no, Daddy knows Jiu-Jitsu.

On Developing Both Intellectual & Physical Sides

We had this whole episode when we correctly set up the hierarchy in Shin-Pal's family, because it was a little off. His son was already challenging him; he's a baby this big. Is that true Shin-Pal? Daddy fixed him up a little bit. I coached him; I showed him how to do it without hitting the child. I just showed the child the masculine power, lifted him up, wrestling him around, threw him around a little bit, safely, "Oh! Grandpa is strong! Golly!" Then, "Okay, give Grandpa a kiss! Okay! Go on boy!" This kind of training. Then after two weeks that boy is happier, he's getting more praise; everybody is like, "Wow! You're such a good boy!" Why? Because that hierarchy has been established clearly; he doesn't think he can boss Daddy around. He literally thought he could beat his daddy up.

I trained his daddy; his daddy can beat up a lot of males, but that little boy was so deluded, he literally thought he could beat his daddy up. While we were eating, I said, "Nope, hold him down, hold him; just hold him. Don't let him go; hold him even though he's crying." He literally thought he could beat Daddy, but after that one training, done! The very next day he realized, "Shoot! I can't beat Daddy!" And then of course Shin-Pal has been training with him ever since then, and boom, he lined up. It's so much better.

This kind of training is so important; you never start anything at high level, you always start as a white belt. That realization is very important because a lot of young people have so much pride. They want to fall for, "If you believe in yourself, you'll be at the top level." That's baloney; that's not how it works. The training and the hard arts teach you, that's not how it works. You have to grind and work hard, you have to get beat up, beat down and you have to get back up again. You got to learn how to self-motivate yourself because not everybody's going to do it for you; mostly people are going to be asking for your demise. Are you with me, folks? These kinds of principles, you don't learn in school or reading a book, and I've read many.

One thing with the intellectual realm of children: if the kids try to go intellectual, they think they're BETTER than other people because they have a higher intellectual quotient. That's a problem. You see these kids that lean intellectual, they think they're literally BETTER than other people or blue-collar workers because, "THEY are just laborers; I'm part of the educated class!" Where have you heard this before? Marxism, communism, that's the centerpiece of the Left; this intellectual arrogance.

But when you train or work with blue-collar folks, you start doing what? They become humanized and you start respecting them; you start realizing, "They have a lot of good qualities. Each person individually has bad qualities but they also have good qualities." You start learning, "Hey, just because I read more books than them or I think I'm smart, I have a higher IQ than them..."

Kids with higher IQ can actually manipulate people, so kids with higher IQ, if they're around kids with lower IQ, they can manipulate them. You'll see this for example in the BLM movement or Antifa. You'll have the higher IQ Lefties be put up in positions of leadership and managing the whole mass group with the lower IQ, and they will keep them on point that way. Then, higher IQ young people learn that, "Oh, I'm smarter than other people. I can actually trick people; I can manipulate them." They learn that, and if they go this route, guess what happens? They become deviant, they become manipulative, they become deceitful and they try to use their intellect to get what they want even though they deceive people. Everybody here has seen those types of "intellectual" people, right? You all have seen that type of personality, right?

That's why in the Rod of Iron Kingdom culture, the kings especially because you're the high priest of our family, you must develop BOTH sides, BOTH physical and intellectual. You must have both because your children and the people you lead will either be generally more one or the other, and especially your kids will try to defeat you. I know that's a weird way to put it but it's true, especially the males; they will try to dominate you and defeat you in the opposite of what you're good at. So, if you're good at athletics, they'll say," Oh, *I don't really like athletics*." But really, they're cowards and they're scared, and they will try to develop just intellectually.

But males need to develop their intellectual side. Things like studying theology, philosophy, understanding counseling and things like this that engage your intellectual mind are very important for raising your children and helping them with their faith life etc. You cannot not develop that side and just do the physical training. Victor Moon, he loves the physical training but he never has been in the habit of studying because he was just a b-boy master performer so he didn't really study a lot. He told me, "I haven't really read a lot of books." I said, "That's fine, no problem; you just build it. Just like you built the b-boy, you just build this intellectual side."

Now, there are different levels of gifting; some people have higher-level gifting. But let me tell you this: you are BETTER than if you never trained at all. So even though you're not gifted intellectually, if you don't train, you're going to be ungifted and have no knowledge there, no skill. At least if you train there a little bit, you may be ungifted but you have some skill. Not everybody's physically gifted, right? When you are teaching people martial arts, you will see that some pick up so slowly. It's not really their fault; it's not their strong gift. This is something you learn as a teacher.

Guidance Based on Training in the King's Family

That's why Joony (Shin-Joon) will also be teaching with Emo in the kids' martial arts program to start to get practice in teaching and understanding that there are different levels. But it's okay;

you've got to learn how to lead all the kids at their different levels. This kind of dynamic of social interplay of raising kids and becoming more capable, this is a very important part of his training as he grows, matures and starts preparing for higher level and more difficult groups of people that he will have to lead.

We're not just winging it; Daddy is training him and I've been training him for twenty freaking years, and these young boys, even as they're married, we continue to train with them and coach them so that they succeed in marriage. For Shin-Pal's and Shin-Man's families, same thing. See? Same thing. I don't like to put them on the spot but they understand that for certain times I have to, because everybody has to understand that what I'm speaking is not theory. This is not theory; this is stuff that we do. We actually train this, and the kids are not at a certain level because they're just gifted there. No! They're at a certain level because Daddy and Mommy are at a certain level. We are at a certain black-belt level and that way we can train them at a certain level.

There are actually levels to this game, just like ANYTHING in life. Now we may not be the best at stock trading or running businesses like Kook Jin Nim, but in terms of spousal relationship training and in terms of training your kids, I mean we're very high level and everybody knows that. I'm not bragging, I'm just telling the truth. It's like me saying, "I'm a black-belt Jiu-Jitsu, I can beat most males," because it's just simply true. The proof is in the pudding, and the children, they're not being put on the spot to be embarrassed. Why? Because they've put a lot of hard work in it too.

They have seen the effectiveness of Daddy's and Mommy's guidance through the years and through the training; all the one-on-one days for twenty plus years etc., prepping them for marriage, telling them the inner secrets and workings of relationships. How many trainings did we do on that? We actually put a lot of teaching into our children. It doesn't just happen; none of this just happens.

Remember, the higher you get publicly, the more stress you have on your individual family. Since Father has put me as his heir and successor, our family in terms of Sanctuary probably has the highest level of stress, because everybody's looking at it. Usually in that situation the families break down. I'm aware of that. I have seen that thing happen and so from a very young age we've been very cautious of that. For example, I warn the young people who grew up with social media and stuff: Don't put your kids all over the TV and all over the social media; don't be doing that! Don't freaking put them in the Truman Show y'all, don't put your children in the Truman Show; they did not ask for that.

Now when they're babies, that's one thing. But once they get to a stage where they're starting to make mistakes, keep them away from the public eye. Are you with me, young people? Keep your children out of the public eye. Not only are the predators trying to hunt them, but they need SPACE to grow up because they're not going to be perfect and you don't want them feeling like they have to put on a SHOW; ever since they were freaking born, being watched by

the dang internet and being criticized by every little troll and Gremlin-Dyke out there. Are you with me, folks? Keep them OFF of the internet; keep your private pictures private even though the CIA and NSA watch them and see them.

I also warn the young people about that: don't be posting any naked pictures of yourself in your phone; don't be taking naked pics of your wife either. You understand? Because NSA perverse pedos are going to be watching them. Are you with me young men? You understand what kind of world we're living in? But that's real. You understand what I'm saying? Is that real? That's real. You got to watch out.

With the younger kids coming up, when they reach a certain age, I always say probably three, four, five, they don't need to be viewed by the whole internet. Let them have a childhood away from prying public predatory eyes. Let them have room to make mistakes with their parents and apologize and get over it. Don't put them in front of the whole world because that's going to backfire on you; don't do that. Keep them away. Let them have their space.

Now when they hit start hitting their teens, then maybe now they want to show some of that badass kind of good toughness to the world, because now they're getting skilled at martial arts etc., and they want to say, "Hey! I'm 15, 16 years old, but look at me; I'm training hard. I'm good at martial arts and this and that," and they want to put that out. For example, that's when my daughter did Gunsweets and we helped her do that.

Because especially girls, the way the girls' world works, and you guys who are older you all know this but younger men, you got to understand: the way the girls' world works is they isolate other women by verbal attacking and verbal isolation. That's how the women's world works. Males will isolate PHYSICALLY generally speaking. So, you have to understand that the females, your daughters will get a lot more verbal like, "Ah! You're just like brainwashed," Or whatever. You see they're going to get heavier because the girls are going to try to guilt-shame them verbally to try to make them get off the straight and narrow, go to Satan's cult and be part of their sex cult. You got to be aware of this.

So, when our daughter came into the teens, I made it a thing to make her look cool and badass and strong. She's not just *A Little House on the Prairie* princess prancing around in the meadow. She would KICK your head off, she would CHOKE your neck, but yet she loves God and she serves her parents. You understand? Daddy helped her do that with the Gunsweets channel and all of that. She had a gift for baking and she learned in homeschooling and became proprolevel baker. But also, she has that whole element where she embraces a strong side of being a protector woman; protector of children, protector of her husband; this kind of culture.

She would shoot the guns or she would train with Daddy. I would have her do techniques on me etc., and put them up. She'd look super dope and all the girls were like, "Oh, dang girl! I didn't know you could do that. Oh my gosh! You're so amazing!" You understand? She could turn it from getting all the shame to getting praise for following the straight and narrow.

The Cheon II Guk Culture

A lot of churches are having this trouble even big rappers like

Bryson Gray https://www.youtube.com/@TysonJamesMusic. Great guys and very hardcore in the Word, but they have a very hard time. They do a whole rap song with gun toting, Bible thumping; rappers, new Christian breed. But they can't explain why they would be gun toting; they can't explain why. The only way you can explain that it is part of the Kingdom culture is if the Lord of the Second Advent returns; that's the only way. Otherwise, it's just a fringe group saying "That's what it is; that's my interpretation of it."

The Lord of the Second Advent has to come and he has to establish his lineage and his Constitution, and that Constitution makes it very clear. That becomes the Rod of Iron Kingdom. Then now it's a very strong CULTURAL dimension of the Kingdom which is of course biblically based and when you look at the Scriptures then you can see, "Wow! That really is God's nature and it is preserving freedom, but it's also an armed responsible society." NOW, you can explain that.

So, the only reason why we can make that kind of strong, bold claim, theologically strong is what? Because the Lord has returned and he's the ultimate authority; he's the ultimate authority. He, in his Kingdom has given freedom and responsibility just like God in the Garden of Eden, so it's not going to be a Christian tyranny. It's not going to be a Christian totalitarianism as many of these leftist churches want to believe in; it's not going to be free welfare from Jesus. This is what they want, "Big government Jesus, come on! Come quickly Lord! Big government Jesus, come save me now!" I'm sorry, that's not it.

No, it's freedom and responsibility where true males become true wonderful strong dangerous benevolent protectors; women also become beautiful protectors, beautiful strong evangelists, etc. And guess what? It's such an amazing culture. We're training, we're riding the iron horse through the wind. Lord, have mercy! We're skydiving for training.



By the way, young people, shout out to Victor Moon. July 24th through 28th the next Fjallraven Classic USA is coming out in Colorado; thirty plus miles through the Rockies.

Boy, we did that training with three of our children Shin-Pal, Shin-Man and Shin-Goong; my daughter did that. That's where my knee blew out because I gave my dang cane to Rio. I remember that, Rio Tashiro; I remember you! Dangonit! I gave you that dang cane and blew my knee out! No, I'm just joking! It was my choice to give it to him so it's my fault. But thirty plus rocking through the freaking Colorado Rockies! What an amazing great training. I'm not doing it again, but it's great training.

For the younger kids and some of the younger people who have not done that, that's coming up, so we have to sign you, young people up. Oh man, your body's going to be hurting like it

never hurt before and you're going to want to quit so bad! The first day is probably the worst. Once you pass the second day it's actually easy, because once you pass the second day the third day is the last day. So, the hardest night is the first night.

You got to see the pace all these professional trekkers freaking running up to dang Rocky Mountains, and you're like, "How the heck are they moving up at this speed?" But they're professional trekkers; it's advanced trekking. It's an advanced course; it's advanced level, it's not beginner-level. We jumped into this event; we never did any trekking like that. We had sixty, seventy-pound packs on. Oh my gosh! I know you Marines do that, but I mean normal civilians don't do that. I mean Dalen and these guys they did it. Did you do the Rocky Mountains? You did the Rockies, right? You did long treks and everything. And they carried a rifle. I mean I carried my dang gun through the whole Colorado; not the rifle but I had a pistol on me. Anyway, that training is coming up.

So why this kind of training? These kinds of training don't get you saved. No! They're part of the Cheon Il Guk culture though; they're part of being a responsible benevolent "love God, love your neighbor" type of person. Because the better you are and the higher level you are. Guess what? You're going to lead people better; you're going to be a better asset for other people; you're going to be a GIFT and a blessing to somebody else. That's why for example Shin-Joon, he's going to be the Third King so he's got to be well versed at a lot of things. Who knows, he may have to join me in a rap session. OH! Lord, have mercy! That's the thing he fears the most; he may have to join Daddy in a rap schedule! Dang, Dang, Dang, Dang! Oh, Lord have mercy!

Overcoming Fear

By the way, the Freedom Festival organizers are begging us to do some King Bullethead performances at the Freedom Festival. (*Applause*) No, no, come on! We're thinking about it but we're going to have everybody included. How's that? We'll have the Rod of Iron Riders up there, we'll have the sisters with a great voice doing a chorus - or whatever, we can plan it outwe'll have Victor Moon and his b-boy team. We'll make it fun; we'll get everybody involved and just celebrate and thank Father.

The point is: we got this training that kids are scared of and we make them encounter it. If you're scared of the water, well guess what? Your training is definitely going to be scuba diving. If you're scared of heights, guess what? Your training is definitely going to be skydiving, et. Why? Why? Because fears aren't permanent. The Bible talks about fear as a spirit. So, when you are DOMINATED by fear, you're being DOMINATED by a demonic spirit, which prevents you from doing God's will and building up the assets and the gifts that He has given you because you have fear.

That's why we can't live with the spirit of fear. That's why the Peace Police- Peace Militia training lifestyle is what? You learn how to do things that you're scared of, that terrify you, like facing somebody in empty-hand combat or freaking jumping off an airplane. But when you do it with people who know how to act safely and help you overcome that fear, then you become somebody that you thought you could not become. That's what the Queen always says in her testimony, "I never thought I'd be riding Harleys and freaking shooting guns and choking necks. I'm just an artist; I like Monet." She always says it in her testimony.

But that's why you want to be around people that are going to push you; they're going to push you to face your fears and be that person, be that gift to many. They're going to push you in your discipline, in your moral fortitude, in your mind state, in your emotional control; they're going to push you in your physical training and push you in your fears, etc. That's the kind of people you want to be around because THOSE people are actually going to build you.

Who's that big boy from California prison? He's now a multi-millionaire. He got big off YouTube after he came out of the Cali prison. Wes Watson! That's that big boy! https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCWUxLYGeelKxxioUqL54Q8g

He talks about this: "You need an a-hole in your life. You need somebody to whoop on you. If you don't have anybody whooping on you, you're soft and you'll never achieve what you could achieve. You need that a-hole in your life; that person's going to push you and whoop you so that you get to the next level. Because you're not going to do it by yourself; people are lazy, complacent." Yeh! That's the big boy! He's an ex-con; he's a bodybuilder, etc.

Father's Amazonian training

That's why the boys got to do this training especially because in the Western world, life has gotten so soft; it's so easy. There's nothing hard about freaking living in the Western world; this modern society is pathetically weak. You have to go live in the freaking jungle in the Amazon. You're going to learn really quick how Third World people think and how they live. You're going to learn very quickly how to survive. That's why I'm thinking that at some point we got to do an Amazon training. How dope would that be?

We could go down to Campo Grande where Father had Jardim, the big property. I don't think it's in our control, but even just spiritually for us as a community, maybe we can organize bushcrafting. There are bushcraft teams that go down there and camp in the jungle; they sleep amongst the leopards, the anacondas, the poisonous snakes and all that. That'd be some GREAT training! We won't hit any cities, so girls, don't get all excited! [Laughter] We're going to hit the jungle, baby!

People don't understand how loud the jungle is. Oh my gosh! When it becomes nighttime, holy shmita! Night time in the desert is quiet, but in the jungle the night time is like living in the middle of New York City. Everywhere are shouts and screams! (*Imitating jungle animals*) It's

crazy! The jungle is nuts at night; night is louder. The daytime is quiet because it's so hot, you sleep in the daytime and try to stay alive at night.

But how dope would that training be! Maybe we'll plan that for a couple of years down the road. That'd be pretty sweet going down right near where Father was in Campo Grande, Mato Grosso https://www.geographicguide.com/brazil/matogrosso-map.htm in that whole Jardim region. We got to find out. Some of our Brazilian brothers must be watching and be jumping up and down right now as they listen to me talking about this. I haven't told them anything about this, but those brothers and sisters in Jardim under Father's authority, please find out that river, that location. We can get close to it probably; they can probably scout out some campsites, public places that we can go to. How sweet would that be! You know you bring your son on these tracks. How sweet would that training be!

Father was right in there! The Lord was right in that region! You understand? I was there every freaking summer. I HATED it! I HATED it when I was young; absolutely detested it. But I have UNFORGETTABLE memories of the jungle, of these red macaws flying everywhere, monkeys jumping around. I'm not joking. We were swinging off vines, jumping, swimming in the river. Huge anaconda right under the rock! "OH! An anaconda!" We're running out. Alligators EVERYWHERE - crocs are in Africa, alligators in South America.



Then they got the capybara, the little pig thing that runs around. That's good eating; that's good eating right there. I mean that's SUCH good training, man! I remember I had such great memories with my brother one year older than me. We were on a boat together. I drove him nuts because I was the prankster

and he's the one that received it all the time. I would drive him nuts, pick at his hair, pick at his ear; just drive him nuts on the boat and I had no qualms about it. It was me, him and a Japanese brother who used to be a Japanese model or something. So, we even made more fun of him because he used to be a model; we used to rag on him more. (*Laughter*)

On the boat there's no bathroom; you got to pee off the boat, and if you're embarrassed that's a pain. I had no problem with that; I got to do my thing. But my brother, he was more insular, he didn't like that kind of stuff, so he could not pee on the boat. When he had to go pee, I would start shaking that boat. It was a little rowboat and I would start shaking it,

I used to drive him nuts. Oh my God! God, forgive me! He could not go on the boat, so we actually had to pull off with all these alligators; we had to pull off for him. We had to beach the boat so he could go into the jungle and take a leak, and while he was at it, I would shout, "Leopard, leopard!" (Laughter) Oh, my gosh! Oh, my Lord!

[&]quot;Hey, you little bastard, stop shaking that boat!" (Laughter) I would say,

[&]quot;Young J-Hyung, I can see it! I can see it! I can see it!" He was going nuts. He'd say,

[&]quot;Hey! Stop looking!" I'd say,

[&]quot;I can see your wee-wee. I can see it; I can see it!"

Oh Lord! But you see, these are incredible memories! We were like idiots but with God's hedge of protection, we swam down the freaking river. There are stingrays there; there are stingrays on the bottom of that river. Stingrays! There are piranhas everywhere; there are anacondas, all type of boas, poisonous snakes, alligators everywhere, jaguars, and we decided, "Hey, let's go swim down the river!" like idiots. The first freaking time we're down there, it's so hot; it's 120 degrees F out there with the Amazonian humidity. We're like, "We got to go swimming. We have no air conditioning in this house, we're going to get in that water." Oh, my goodness! We ended up swimming down that river. Thank God nothing happened, because we were swimming over everything. We were probably stepping on stingrays. Oh my gosh! I don't know how we survived honestly speaking. It's just ridiculous! There are actually kids that died; they got sucked in the waterfalls near Jardim and they actually died playing around in the stream. They got sucked in and they died. So, it's not a joke.

But this kind of thing that's a tremendous experience that Father gave us. We hated it when we were doing it, but now thirty years later ... Oh my gosh, thirty years have gone by! Wow! Thirty years later, we're grateful, so grateful. He didn't take us to go see the city, he took us to the jungle or to Kodiak, Alaska where nobody is on the freaking island with the bears. Oh my gosh! Freaking minus forty degrees in the winter! Oh, my Lord! Also, Alaska winter has no sunlight. It's dark all day; there are like two hours of light.

But this kind of thing, how amazing would that be! It would be a great training. Oh yeah! How amazing that would be! We'll start talking with our Brazilian folks and maybe do a camp out there or something. How sweet would that be to camp in the jungle going back to Father's Amazonian training! Oh my gosh! How dope would that be? That'd be pretty dope, man!

Okay, let's jump down to the key point. Let's go to verse 19 here:

5 John 19-20

¹⁹ Then answered Jesus and said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, The Son can do nothing of himself, but what he seeth the Father do: for what things soever he doeth, these also doeth the Son likewise.

That father-son unity is critical. Father gave me those kinds of incredible experiences; I want to give those to my sons, and I want to give them to the sons of God here. You know what I mean? How amazing that would be to get that training down there and experience that actual area! Wouldn't that be sweet? Have you boys been down there? Yes, some of you have.

- ²⁰ For the Father loveth the Son, and sheweth him all things that himself doeth: and he will shew him greater works than these, that ye may marvel.
- ²¹ For as the Father raiseth up the dead, and quickeneth them; even so the Son quickeneth whom he will
- ²² For the Father judgeth no man, but hath committed all judgment unto the Son:
- ²³ That all men should honour the Son, even as they honour the Father. He that honoureth not the Son honoureth not the Father which hath sent him.
- ²⁴ Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.
- ²⁵ Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live.

Isn't that incredible? The dead will hear the voice! Whew! This is Jesus speaking. Hello! These are red letter verses; red letters. He said it. He's saying,

- --- The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the Son of God: and they that hear shall live.
- ²⁶ For as the Father hath life in himself; so hath he given to the Son to have life in himself;
- ²⁷ And hath given him authority to execute judgment also, because he is the Son of man.
- ²⁸ Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice,
- ²⁹ And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

That's why all the traditional denominations believe they're going to come back in the physical body. But we know about resurrection through ancestral liberation that Father anointed through the lineage; working with the lineage on earth. These are verses that are connected with what we call the ancestral liberation or the connecting of the spiritual realm with the physical lineage and with Christ, but they have to work through a physical central figure. In the Heying clan that would be Jerry, etc. You know, that's how returning resurrection works.

But notice that Jesus speaks about "ALL in the graves." Whoa! So, is Jesus a necromancer? He was talking to dead people, that all the dead would hear him. Is he a necromancer? No, of course not. He's one with the Father, one with God. That's why right alignment and right relationship will happen through the relationship with Christ. And in the future period after the Second Coming of Christ then it would be connected to the physical lineage, the relational body that's on earth. It would be connected to the spiritual realm, and then basically they would receive new life through their physical lineage that's now getting connected to CHRIST's physical

KINGDOM. Because his Kingdom is not just spiritual; the Kingdom is not supposed to be just spiritual. The Bible promises a physical Kingdom; physical, not spiritual only; physical.

Whoo! That's why training in the physical world is so important. How great was that training yesterday! Let's give it up for CJ (Thompson) and a wonderful training! (*Applause*) https://www.360tacticaltraining.com/ What a beautiful day! God blessed us with such a beautiful weather yesterday. Oh my gosh! How beautiful that weather was! Oh, my Lord! It was phenomenal!

The Rod of Iron Kingdom

The physical earth realm is so important because that's where we develop our mind and body unity. A more common word would be discipline, have dominion over your urges and desires, learn how to have unity through mind and body training. Those kinds of things are important. That's very important in what? In marriage. In marriage it's very important to have discipline, especially as the priest and king of the house; discipline over what? Your emotions. Don't get flustered; know how to lead with confidence. Important; very, very, important! So, mind and body unity, then spousal and family training and then of course dominion over creation, which is what? Kingdom building, spiritual Kingdom building, physical Kingdom building, dominion over creation, Rod of Iron training, Peace Police and Peace Militia training to have dominion over the created order.

This is what's so incredible, because wherever Eve goes -Eve is the representative of women-wherever woman goes, what happens? The culture goes. Why? Because the women have the eggs, they have the next generation and the males in the population are trying to hunt for the eggs. If the women go towards Satan, the beta males will go after the godly males that don't want to go for them, because when they get rid of the alpha males, now they can get access to those eggs since the women have chosen Satan. You see what I'm saying?

All throughout history, and we learned this in the fall, women are where the culture is, and also where the sexuality goes because women have the access to the eggs, access to sexuality. If the women choose licentiousness, they get access to all the evil males, and guess what happens to the society? It plummets. It plummets, it gets destroyed; all the violent evil predators take it. Absolute sex and romance is also physical, isn't it? So, the more physical things you do, the more romantic huh? Oh! Oh! What a connection! Hey! Come on!

Very, very, important. Don't just live an intellectual lifestyle. Booh! Booh!

okay. Be exciting, be romantic, work out, BE excited, GO on bike ride, GET in training, DO dangerous things, PRAISE God! That's the Kingdom right there. Praise God! You got to do that kind of stuff. Don't be just boring little intellectual computer no-skill bumbos addicted to video games. NO! No! You got to be attractive. You all have it within you; you just got to kill those habits and build good habits. Amen! Let's give glory onto God! (*Applause*)
