Suggested Guidelines for Matching Candidates of Sanctuary Blessed Life

1. Candidates may contact other candidates through their parents. Usually, the first contact is with the parents of 2nd generation candidates. Please be respectful, especially when there is a significant age difference (we suggest a maximum of 10 years).

2. Candidates should communicate with only one other candidate at a time.
3. When communicating with another candidate, please hide your profile - there is an option on the site to do so.
4. If you wish to decline communicating with another candidate, please do so respectfully, in the manner you would like to be treated.
5. We suggest each candidate have at least two matching photos on their profile: one face-only and one full-body. More is better. Family photos are also nice.
6. Update your photos if they no longer look like you. Please do not cover your face.
7. In the essay sections, please avoid one-word answers. Promote yourself humbly, as God sees you - be honest yet respectful.
8. Review your profile from time to time and update it where necessary.
9. Candidates may select a matching advocate for assistance. Please note: the advocate's role is not to find a match for you, but to offer support and occasionally suggest a candidate from the site.
10. Candidates should take full responsibility for ascertaining relevant information about another candidate before making a commitment - such as HIV/AIDS and STD screening, divorce papers, etc.
11. Please remove yourself from Sanctuaryblessedlife.org once you are Matched or Blessed, or no longer wish to be on the site.
12. Provide an email address or another way to be reached, and please respond within one week.
