On February 22, 1914 of the lunar calendar Mrs. Hong Soon-ae (Daemonim) was bourn at Anju, South Pyeongan Province. On November 3, 1989, she past away when she was 76 years old.

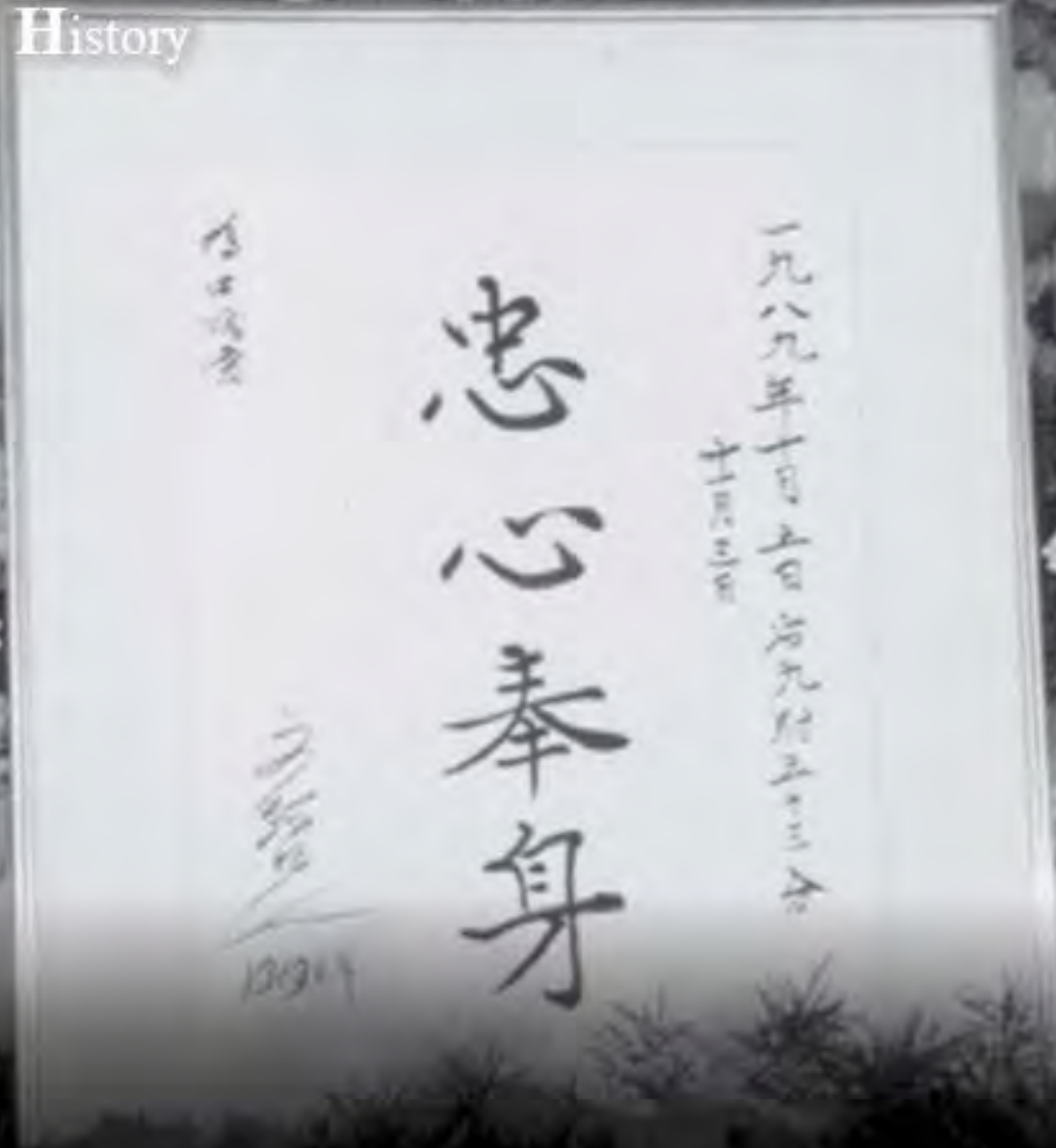


Mrs. Hong Soon-ae went through the path away and it could not be stand and understood by others.

After this, on November 7, 1994,
Daemonimn memorial museum was opened
at Seoul, Korea.
