Our Longest War: Thoughts on the 68th Anniversary of the Korean Armistice

TUESDAY, JULY 27
2-3 PM EDT

The Korean Armistice Agreement is an armistice that brought about a complete cessation of hostilities of the Korean War. It was signed by U.S. Army Lieutenant General William Harrison Jr. representing the United Nations Command, North Korean General Nam Il representing the Korean People's Army, and Peng Teh-huai representing the Chinese People's Volunteer Army. The armistice was signed on 27 July 1953, and was designed to "ensure a complete cessation of hostilities and of all acts of armed force in Korea until a final peaceful settlement is achieved."

Panelists will explore the following themes:

- "A story of whales and shrimps: Geopolitics and North Korea of Kim Jung-un."
- "Reflections on peace between the two Koreas"
- "How have South Koreans thrived for 7 decades with the absence of peace with North Korea?"
