UPF Peru Appoints more than 30 new Ambassadors for Peace on Day of Peace

Peru - More than 30 new Ambassadors for Peace were appointed in a forum for the UN International Day of Peace, held last Tuesday, September 21, 2021 in the auditorium of the Congress of the Republic of Peru, Alberto Andrade Carmona. The meeting was sponsored by Universal Peace Federation Peru branch and the office of a congressman of the Republic and Ambassador for Peace, José Arriola Tueros.



The forum brought together outstanding leaders and Ambassadors for Peace who shared their thoughts and experiences with the audience related with the main theme of the 2021 UN International Day of Peace: "Recovering better for an equitable and sustainable world." Likewise, UPF Peru president, Dr. Trevor Jones, who virtually participated in the forum, called the audience to join UPF's initiatives and work together for peace.

The installation of new Ambassadors for Peace ceremony was chaired by Mr. Jaime Fernández, secretary general of UPF Peru. The forum featured an artistic performance of the dance of scissors, "Danza de las Tijeras," by Ambassador for Peace Roberto Saire Llana.
