

Graduation of the 1st Class of the Hyojeong Academy of South America

The graduation ceremony of the 1st class of the Hyojeong Academy of South America was held on December 11 at the FFWPU headquarters in Brazil. The event was attended by 200 people, including the 29 cadets of the first generation.

The Hyojeong Academy is an educational program focused on training Cheon Il Guk leaders in South America with Pure Water youth as its central axis. For one year, the cadets received education aligned with God's and True Parents' vision, committing to its practice.

Then, FFWPU Vice President Samuel Ota Linhares led the opening prayer, after which the cadets solemnly entered the auditorium.

After screening a video about their activities throughout the year, cadets Franz Quispe and Miwa Oliveira shared their testimonies, expressing their determination to move forward with a spirit of love and absolute

obedience.

Leaders from various districts offered congratulatory messages, followed by words of encouragement from Kim Seong-nam, Director of South America's Cheon Shim Won. Then, the cadets reflected on True Mother's heart while watching a video of her message at the Shin Top Gun mission inauguration ceremony in February 2024.
