WFWP: Public Speaking Training Seminar





Last Saturday on 11th July, Women's Federation Bromley chapter, together with Mitty Tohma, organised a very successful Public Speaking Training seminar. It was delivered by David Rennie, who is a brilliant and experienced Public Speaking Trainer, amongst other high qualifications. David is a long-term WFWP UK supporter and honorary member (yes, brothers can join too), and his wife Christa is serving as WFWP UK Secretary General.

The seminar was attended by 12 participants and had two parts. One was dedicated to David's "I Can Speak In Public" presentation, where he gave a detailed explanation of the importance of having a clear plan, the right attitude, and how to know and use the proper techniques to be able to communicate effectively one's core ideas to the audience.

The second part was the training itself, in which each participant gave a short speech on the topic "Ladies, please join me in peace building!" after 10 minutes of preparation. David gave each trainee individual support and advice for improvement. We all really felt a lot of spiritual energy through his talks; he went above and beyond just presenting a public speaking seminar. He's a real "peace maker"! It was a privilege to be there.
