

I'm in the planning stage, working with a small team, to deliver a programme for training worship leaders. I'm also leading the monthly prayer meetings.

Tithing


Many members of our community have set up a standing order with their bank to offer their tithing regularly. This is especially helpful at this time when we cannot meet in
