Pastor's Report from Matthew

Hi everyone.

Next weekend we will celebrate the 67th birthday of our community together with True Mother. Details are just emerging, but it looks like there will be a celebration starting at 1:30am on Sunday 13th June. The anniversary itself – which is celebrated with Day of True All Things – will be on Thursday 10th June, so on that morning I invite you to offer a Family Pledge Service with a holy table. Please take a photo of your family and send it to me or to David Franklin, so that we can send it to True Mother and share our joy with her!

The last month has been very exciting. The main project I have been working on is a **Worship Training Programme**. Back in 2020, the Bromley committee met many times to create a strategic plan for this year, and one of the activities we wanted to do this year was to organise training for worship leaders to improve the quality of our worship services. Although this started as a local initiative, it quickly drew the attention of the regional Pastors Association, which led to hundreds of people across our region to be invited. 164 individuals from 29 nations have registered for this programme, with 35 participants from the UK and 5 participants from Bromley. So far two high quality sessions have been completed, with the final session taking place this Tuesday. At the end of the programme a set of guidelines will be edited and distributed as a manual to support local communities in delivering professional worship services.

Recently, the Bromley Committee completed a series of Saturday evening meetings in which we shared our life stories with each other. It has been incredibly precious to learn about our backgrounds, about how we came to meet True Parents, and about the kaleidoscope of experiences within our Unification movement. I highly recommend that everyone makes some time to hear the testimonies of our brothers and sisters in our Bromley family.


I attended a couple of meetings with the other UK pastors this month. One of the issues we addressed was the need to collect more accurate data about the national

membership. Many of you have responded to the invitation to complete the form to update your profile, for which I am very grateful. We have also discussed how to help our members with their spiritual growth, recognising that everyone has varying levels of capacity and commitment, and considering what we can do to help everyone grow wherever they are right now.

It has also been very meaningful to have some lengthy conversations with some folks on the phone. We also continue to join in with the North London Sunday School once per month, which is always a great opportunity for both Bromley and North London children to meet each other.



Many members of our community have set up a standing order with their bank to offer their tithing regularly. This is especially helpful at this time when we cannot meet in person for our Sunday Service.


