

When can I attend the Special Grace 1-day education?


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When God gave the Ten Commandments to Moses at Mount Sinai, all the Hebrews gathered together for a shared experience in which they received profound instruction and met God. The shared journey they experienced, as described especially in Exodus 19, is what many of us experienced when we participated on an educational workshop: we went on a journey where we learnt about God's truth, we encountered God intimately, and we shared that experience with a community of workshop participants. Try remembering the emotions we experienced on those workshops; whenever we meet people who participated on those workshops, there's an instant connection of heart as we recall those shared memories.

Over the next month and a half, there will be an opportunity for us to have another experience like that in our local communities.

On this website, there is information about the Special Grace & Holy Gifts offered to us by True Mother, as well as the 40-day period of devotion that constitutes one of the five conditions requested to be offered in preparation to receive them. One of those conditions is to participate on a 1-day programme of education. Let's aim to make our attendance of these programmes another crowd *theophany*, a community meeting with God.



The European Blessed Family & Education Department has developed a workbook, a copy of which will be printed and distributed to every member aged over 16 via the local community. While the content we study will be identical, each community is hosting their education programmes on different dates and in different formats. While it would be advisable to attend a programme in your local community, we understand that our lives are busy and if it is impossible to attend a programme in your local community, you could join a programme in another community if that is more convenient.
