### The 2020 Sunhak Peace Prize Laureates Have Been Announced



The Sunhak Peace Prize Committee have selected Macky Sall, 59, President of Senegal, and Munib A. Younan, 70, former President of the Lutheran World Federation, as the 2020 Sunhak Peace Prize Laureates. In addition, to mark the 100th anniversary of the birth of its founder Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon, a special Founders' Award will be given to Ban Ki-moon, 76, the former UN Secretary-General.

The Sunhak Peace Prize aims to discover and award individuals and/or organizations that have contributed to peace and welfare of future generations. The prize was established to honour the legacy of Rev. Sun Myung Moon, and the life he led in order to realise 'One Family Under God.' The prize of \$1 million US dollars is the largest single award in the world. The winner of the Founders' Award will receive \$500,000 US dollars.

The award ceremony will be held next year at the KINTEX in Seoul, South Korea, on February 5th, 2020.
