

1521st Hyojeong CheonBo Workshop held at the Cheonseong Wanglim Palace

On 12.4 by the heavenly calendar in the 8th year of Cheon Il Guk (January 16, 2021), the 1521st Hyojeong CheonBo Workshop was held in the main and small halls of the Cheonseong Wanglim Palace.

The workshop was conducted using an online platform to stream the program to local churches and training centers around the world. About 20 members of the training center staff attended off-line, offering sincere jeongseong while conforming carefully to COVID-19 social distancing protocols.





A total of 20,932 people registered for Ancestor Liberation, Collateral Liberation, and Ancestor Blessing. The entire schedule was led by Education Department Director In-sung Moon, starting from 1:10 p.m. The program progressed as follows: a holy song, opening announcements, gyeongbae, family pledge, report prayer, and a Hyojeong Today news video, President Gi-seong Lee's opening address: The Grace of Ancestor Liberation and Blessing, chanyang for the Ancestor Liberation Ceremony, Cheonshim Won prayer, and Ancestor Blessing Ceremony, followed by closing remarks at 5:10 p.m.





The Blessing Ceremony that was part of 1521st Hyojeong CheonBo Special Workshop included Ancestors in generations 1–430 of the paternal line, maternal line, father's maternal line, and mother's maternal line at the main hall of Cheonseong Wanglim Palace. Planning Department Director Jong-jin Kim led the service, which included the following main elements: invocation (Vice President Myong-kwan Lee), officiator's message (President Gi-seong Lee and his wife), Blessing ceremony, and benediction prayer.
