### UPF Celebrates 20 Years of Global Peacebuilding

This month marks the 20th anniversary of the founding of the Universal Peace Federation, inaugurated on September 12, 2005, by Rev. Dr. Sun Myung Moon and Dr. Hak Ja Han at Lincoln Center in New York. Over the past two decades, UPF has grown into a global alliance of peacebuilders, partnering with governments, civil society, and faith communities to promote dialogue, cooperation, and sustainable development.





### UN Forum: Empowering Youth for a Culture of Peace

New York, United States – On Sept. 2, 2025, the UN High-Level Forum on the Program of Action on the Culture of Peace 2025 took place at the UN Headquarters Trusteeship Council Chamber on the theme: "Empowering Youth on a Culture of Peace." Convened by H.E Mr. Philemon Yang, president of the 79th Session of the UN General Assembly, the forum emphasized harmony, friendship, and solidarity, with youth at the center of peace and development worldwide. The Committee on Spirituality, Values and Global Concerns-NY (CSVGC-NY), of which UPF is a member, was invited to participate in these proceedings.
