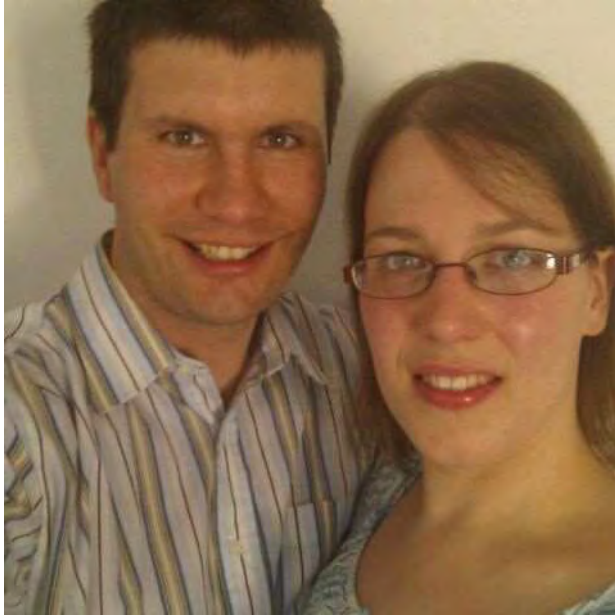


Sincerely search our deepest part and seek God's love and wisdom
