WFPW Jordan is working very hard to support & empower youth, refugees and women to be good decision-makers in their families and societies in order to build good families – emotionally and financially.

**WFPW Jordan is initiating projects in areas such as:**

- YOUTH:** Offering scholarship aid, educational courses, and supporting an Iraqi refugee soccer team and the Iraqi refugee youth both financially and psychologically.
- AID:** Providing food boxes during Holy Ramada and supporting Iraqi refugee families.
- WFPW JORDAN WOMEN'S TRAINING CENTER:** Established in the needy week of Arimat in 2000, offering courses in sewing, beautician, health-maintaining exercise, massage, English, computer, handcraft and mathematics.
- MICRO FINANCE:** Financing \$150 to \$850 per person without interest. To be paid back in ten-month installments. WFPW Jordan provides advice on life-planning and administration when the monthly repayment is collected. More than 1000 women have received financing and some of the businesses that have come out of it includes grocery shops, second-hand clothing shops, hair shops, stationary shops and beauty salons. The repayment rate is 99%.
