On June 23, 2000,

UN IAEWP(International Association Of Educators For World Peace) awards the Grand Prix Peace Prize to True Mother.

This prize has been known as the world-level authority and called “the Nobel Prize in the Educational Field”.

It is given to the person who worked hard with the development of Education and Human Authority.

This is the first time that Korean woman was awarded in the world.

In 1992, True Mother established the Women's Federation for creating the World Peace.

She visited 113 main cities in 40 countries and emphasised the women's authority in society and world peace.



Furthermore, True Mother was invited to the speaking tour in UN headquarters, China, Russia, Japan, and the U.S.. At that time, it was impossible that an Asian woman was invited and had a speech in front of the governmental and educational representatives.



The award ceremony was scheduled to hold at the Millennium in London, but it was changed into Seoul in Korea for celebrating 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the end the Korean War.

This prize has the providential importance that the UN accepts True Mother's World Peace Movement.

The term “interreligious” does not fit with religions as they have existed up to now. We must present a new global pathway for religions. The term “international,” or “transnational,” is a term that does not fit with the political climate of the UN as it has been up to now. These words mean “transcending nationality and religion.” In the same vein, I have been preparing an institution that will take us beyond the present media and financial structures in order to impact the direction of the world.

With this in mind, we have created an institution to link to the UN, which we have named the Interreligious and International Federation for World Peace. Now we must gather the NGOs in various fields and elevate the work of the UN.
