On August 5, 2007,
the building ceremony of the world peace center at
Pyongyang in the North Korea to open the gate for
uniting north and south Korea.



On this day, it was finished to build the dedicated world peace center by Pyeonghwa Motors Group at Pyongyang. The building construction had been continued from 1997 and after 10 years later, the modern convention center was built.



The world peace center stands for overcoming difficulties coming from the government issue between South and North Korea.

The world peace center is the first building which South Korea managed this project. This is the first time for South Korea to design the building in North Korea. Furthermore, this project brought the opportunity both for South and North Korea to cooperate each other.





This building consist of B1F and 1~5F.

The rooms are some international conference rooms, seminar rooms used for culture/education/religion, and some lecture rooms.

There are more various rooms there.

On the third floor
of the world peace center,
there is the Pyongyang FFWPU chapel.

Following my meeting with President Kim, we now operate the Pyeonghwa Motors plant, the Potonggang Hotel, and the World Peace Center in North Korea,. There are billboards for Pyeonghwa Motors around Pyeongyang. When the South Korean president visited North Korea, North Korean officials took him to the Pyeonghwa Motors plant.

South Korean business leaders who accompanied the president stayed at the Potonggang Hotel. Non-North Korean members of our church who work in North Korea gather at the World Peace Center each Sunday for worship service.

All of these projects are efforts for the sake of peaceful exchanges and unification of North and South. They are not being done to make a profit. They are efforts to contribute to the unification of North and South as an expression of love for the Korean people.
