Rev. and Mrs. Hyung Jin Moon arrived in North Korea on Friday as the head of a delegation sent by True Parents to take part in a commemoration of the historic meeting between North Korean supreme leader

Kim Il-sung and True Father 20 years ago.

True Parents were in North Korea from November 30 to December 7, 1991, undertaking an extremely dangerous mission to meet Kim Il-sung. Due to the dictatorial nature of the North Korean regime, True Parents were putting their lives on their line with their visit. However, through his meeting with Kim Il-sung, True Father (from a secular viewpoint) made a foundation for greater North-South cooperation and interaction, and (spiritually) brought a great victory for God and made brotherly ties with Kim Il-sung. Father honored Kim Il-sung as his elder brother, just as Jacob honored Esau in the Old Testament. Rev. and Mrs. Hyung Jin Moon and their delegation, which includes Peter Kim, Sang Kwon Park, Ken Doo, a Segye Times reporter and a Peace TV videographer, are scheduled to remain in North Korea until this Friday, the 16th. Although detailed information about the trip is as of yet unavailable due to communication restrictions in North Korea, the North Korean government-controlled Korean Central News Agency has released a video of the visit entitled "Delegation of World Peace Federation Arrives":
